HORRIBLE CALAMITY BY FIRE.

WARROAD, Min., Oct. 10—Beaudette, Spooner, Pitt, and Graceton, Minn., were yesterday wiped off the map by the most terrible forest fire ever experienced by the Minnesota settlers.

Yesterday morning the bodies of seventy-five settlers were found, and the death roll will be upwards of three hundred.

Wagon loads of corpses are constantly being brought into the railway station at Beaudette.

Many settlers, crazed with grief at the loss of families and property, are roaming the woods, and searching parties are constantly going out after injured, dead and demented. One family of nine, one of seven and one of five were wiped out.

The fire attacked Beaudette and Spooner, and within three minutes after the first alarm every building was ablaze. Within an hour they were heaps of ashes.

The people of these towns had just time to quit their homes with only what they had on their backs. They were placed on passenger trains standing at the depot and taken across to Rainy River, Ontario, to safety.

The whole country is on fire. Roosevelt, Swift, Williams and Cedar Spur are in great danger.

All the women and children are being removed to places of safety.

The Canadian Northern Railway has stationed trains at every station at the service of the people and is doing everything in its power to relieve the situation. The people of Beaudette and Spooner and the settlers through the north-central part of the state have lost everything.

Five thousand are homeless, and the greater part destitute.

Help must reach them in the next day or two; for the greater part are but half clad, and cold weather is likely to set in at any time.

CHAS. HEFFLER IS ACQUITTED.

HALIFAX, Oct. 8—In the Supreme Court yesterday afternoon Charles Heffler, charged with attempting to shoot George Fournier on the 23rd day of August, was honorably acquitted.

Evidence brought out the fact that Mr. Heffler was not to blame or was not in any way the aggressor in the row. He merely fired the revolver for assistance or to frighten Fournier into desisting from attacking him. There was no evidence at all which would implicate Mr. Heffler as being guilty of the crime, and the jury could do nothing but acquit him.

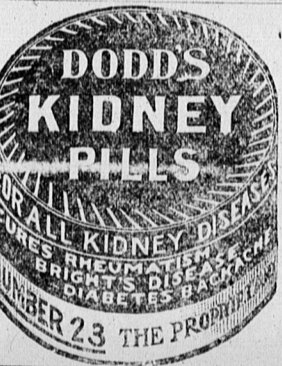
