LESSON VIII. MAY 21.
 SONG OF THE VINEYARD.
 (Temperance Lesson.)
 Isaiah 5: 1-12.
GOLDEN TEXT.
 "Woe unto them that are mighty to drink wine, and men of strength to mingle strong drink."—Is. 5: 22.
POINTED SUGGESTIONS.
 By Rev. D. W. Snider.
 Let not the tease and torment that has come from some sources by reason of contention over the authorship of some of the chapters which have been credited to Isaiah prevent anyone from an appreciative and receptive reading of the prophecy as a whole. Place yourself in the hands of a literary master as well as in those of one of the strongest characters of whom we have knowledge in all the files of time.

In the lesson he speaks and teaches in parable. It is a sample of the music and the march, the beauty and the power of Isaiah. It is the eloquence of fiery and quenchless conviction clothed in the charm of an all-alluring and forceful style.

But what is he talking about? He is unfolding to his day and time the sad and awful spiritual condition to which the nation, which should be as a fruitful vineyard, has come. He reveals the social corruption that exists. He clearly sets forth the impending and inevitable doom. He relentlessly lays bare the forces which are at work in the lives of the guilty. But with it all, as in verse 25, there is the hopeful gleam of the evangelist.

Ingratitude, rank and glaring ingratitude, that thing "sharper than a serpent's tooth," too base to return a kindness and too proud to regard it, wantonly forgetful of an Almighty Benefactor, "while the ox knoweth his owner and the ass his master's crib," ingratitude, more shameless than meanness, has become the root sin of the men of Judah and Jerusalem who have disappointed Jehovah.

But to willfully disappoint Jehovah cannot fail to bring forth the desolating consequences of rejection by Jehovah. Where no soil is tilled no crop can grow. Where no defender is, the enemy can come. What a troop of sins the devil can send tramping over the soul that ingratitude has estranged from God!

It is noteworthy that the greed of gold and the lust for pleasure are the two great outward and visible signs of inward and spiritual decay in the lives of men and nations. The same social and economic features and conditions appear wherever God is not honored.

These signs are sufficiently in evidence today to make good men tremble for their country and for their times.

But there are other and nobler things to do than to lift the mere cry of alarm. Every energy ought to be exerted in the name of God and righteousness to summon men to obey the teaching of the prophet, namely, "Cease to do evil; learn to do well," and to come at once to reason together. There is rightening and cleansing with the Lord.

The economic burden, the moral ruin, the fierce and awful desolation, the unmitigated curse of the liquor traffic; the home-squandering, child-degrading, heart-breaking, soul-destroying, irredeemable drink evil must be put to its death. By moral suasion, and scientific teaching, and legislative decree, and rigorous law enforcement; by aroused public and private conscience and the application of every force of indignation and outraged righteousness; by example, by influence, by prayer, by vote—let it be put to death.




