MOLYNEUX FEATURES PLEATS AS TRIMMING

LONDON, Nov. 27 Short fur jackets, three-quarter coats light redingotes and large-pleated dresses accented the winter fashion show in the House of Molyneux.

Pleats in particular, play an important role this year as trimming. Skirts are entirely pleated or pleat groups are concentrated in front and back. Stitched pleats also are worked on jackets and blouses and even on pockets.

Seam stitching and quilting are other favored trimmings and are used on dresses, skirts and pockets. Dress hems frequently are bordered with stitched design, embroidery or ruching.

Buttons also are important in the Molyneux collection. Coats are buttoned from the neckline to the hem. One black dress showed buttons sewn on a line diagonally across, while an exquisite evening jacket carried a row of glittering rhinestone buttons all the way down the back.

Even-skirts are straight and narrow and reach to the calf, with pleating either in front or back. Slim-in and patch pockets are used on suits, coats and dresses.

For sports and travel ensembles, there is a rich choice of materials and colors. Small and large checks in gray and black or beige and brown are especially smart. Gray in various shades and black, navy, blue, pale blue and Bordeaux are used for daytime clothes. Night-blue and mauve are preferred shades for evening.

Trimmed hats matching the dress-styl's accompany sports and street ensembles while little toques and turbans complement more formal dress.

Sports ensembles are matched,

with hoods which often continue to form a little cape.
