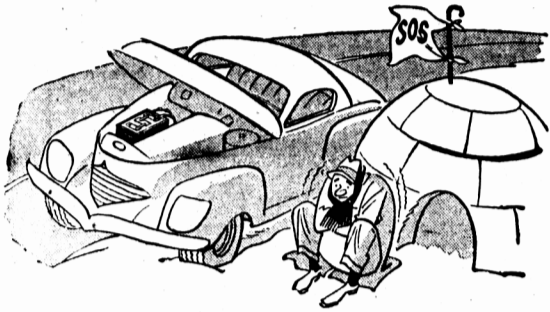

**Margarine From Nfld. After Next March 31**

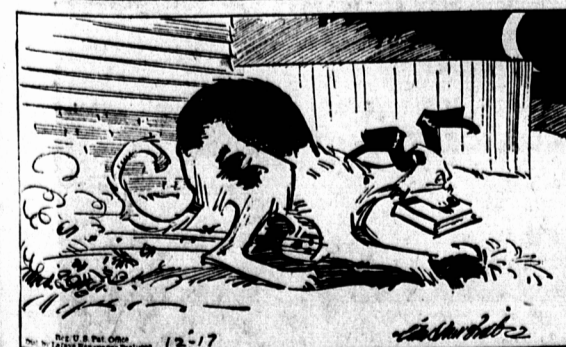
TORONTO, Dec. 14—(CP)—At least one Canadian company can start selling margarine in Canada after March 31 when Newfoundland officially becomes part of the Dominion.

C. A. Massey of Lever Brothers commenting on the Supreme Court

decision permitting sale and manufacture of butter substitutes in Canada, said his company's plant in Newfoundland has a surplus production of margarine available for the Canadian market and will import it from there as soon as Newfoundland's entry into confederation makes it possible.

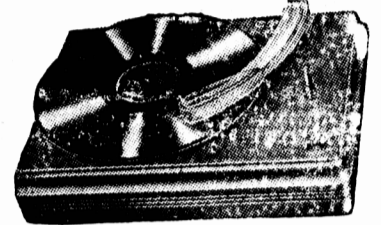
