CANADIAN COAL FIELDS AND COAL NEEDS.

Canada has an enormous area of coal lands, estimated in the report of the Conservation Commission at 29,957 square miles.

Alberta is destined to be the great coal producing Province of the Dominion, having half the estimated quantity of bituminous coal within the bounds of Canada.

And yet the Dominion, so far as the bulk of its population is concerned, is rather badly off for coal.

about the people of Canada last year \$27,500,000. Coal furnishes the motive power for our railways, steamers and factories and is the household fuel in the cities great and small which contain one-fourth part of the population of Canada.

Since 1886, a period of 25 years, the production of coal in Canada has increased from two million tons to 10 1/2 million tons.

The decreasing wood supply in all the older Provinces, together with the increasing demands of transportation and manufacturing, and the frequent prolonged strikes of miners in both the east and west of Canada, and the States has made the fuel problem a vital one in our severe winter climate.
