REPORTS from the Eastern part of the Province state that the lobster fishery during the past week has been an utter failure, the rough weather prohibiting the prosecution of the fishery.

MR. GEO. MCKINNON, principal of the Murray River graded school has resigned. His friends will regret to learn that his resignation was caused by ill health. On Wednesday the last day Mr. McKinnon taught Inspector McCormac visited and inspected the school.

MR. FRANK G. O'NEIL, son of Mr. George O'Neil of Vernon River and brother of Mr. Joseph O'Neil, law student of this city will be ordained priest at Baltimore tomorrow morning by Bishop Curtis and will celebrate his first Mass in St. Joachim's Church, Vernon River, next Sunday.

A GENTLEMAN who is a position to know states that the village of Murray River is growing faster than any other village in the province. At the present time the stores of Prowse Bros. and G.D. Cameron have established branch stores and are doing well and larger trade is looked for when the railway is completed.

THE death took place at North River on Tuesday last of Miss L. B. Molyneux, daughter of the late John Molyneux at the early age of 21 years. Some time ago she removed to Boston where she contracted la grippe which developed into consumption and on Saturday took passage by the S. S. Halifax arriving in Charlottetown on Tuesday, June 4th. One week later she entered the haven where pain and the stormy billows of life assailed her, expressing implicit confidence in her Master in the valley and the shadow. The funeral took place on Thursday morning interment being made in Crapaud.

LADY Laurier has intended going with Sir Wilfred to the Yukon this summer, and as the Premier's wife is very fond of seeing new places and things, she is no doubt disappointed that owing to the coming of the Duke and Duchess of York the trip has been called off. Sir Wilfred will accompany the royal visitors across the continent, and Mr. Sifton, unless he changes his plans will go alone to the North centre. Arthabaskville will probably be Lady Laurier's residence for the most of the summer but a visit to Prince Edward Island during the month of August is contemplated by the Premier and Lady Laurier. Lady Davies is at present deeply engaged in the task of packing up, putting things away and getting the Metcalfe street house ready for the advent of carpenters, painters and plumbers, for during the summer months some repairs and improvements are to be made in it. Early next week Lady Davies and her daughters hope to get down to their charming summer home overlooking the harbor at Charlottetown.—Ottawa Free Press.
