

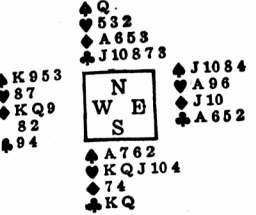
Contract Bridge

A CLEVER HOAX

Yesterday's column illustrated the so-called "legitimate" use to which a singleton in dummy can be put by an expert declarer.

South dealer. Both sides vulnerable.



The bidding: South 1♥, West 2♥, East 2♥, South 4♥.

North's raise was the least of evils on his particular holding.

West, with nothing much to go by, decided to open a trump. East, of course, could have taken the ace and led a second round, but he figured that West might get in before he did and, if he led a second trump, East could take out all of dummy's cards in the suit.

It was not an attractive prospect that South faced. The enemy had disclosed an unmistakable determination to prevent spade ruffing in dummy, and if South tried both to get out the trumps and establish dummy's club suit, the defenders would certainly knock out dummy's diamond entry, and that would be that.

On due consideration, South saw that his best chance was to throw some dust in the opponents' eyes, to mislead them about his specific strength. So, at the second trick, he led a low spade.

This play had a remarkable outcome. West put up the spade king, convinced that the declarer was planning to ruff spades. This time East won with the ace, and, placing the spade ace in his own partner's hand, returned his last trump. South now led the club king, and East jumped on the trick to re-announce when South produced the ace, cashed the club queen, then went to dummy with a diamond and ran the club suit.

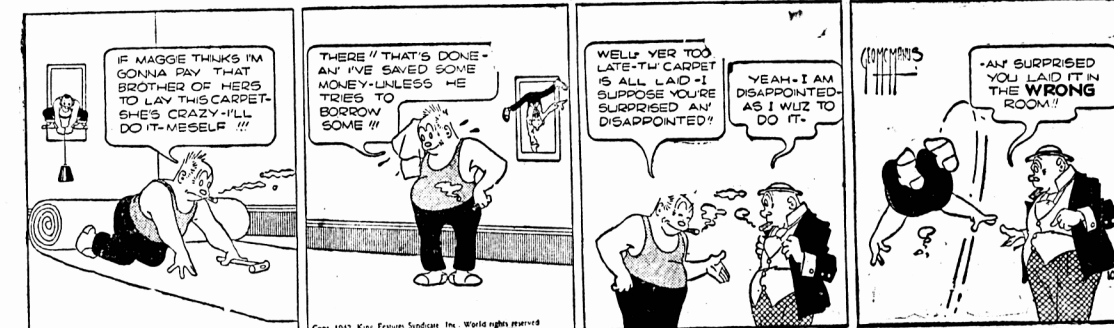

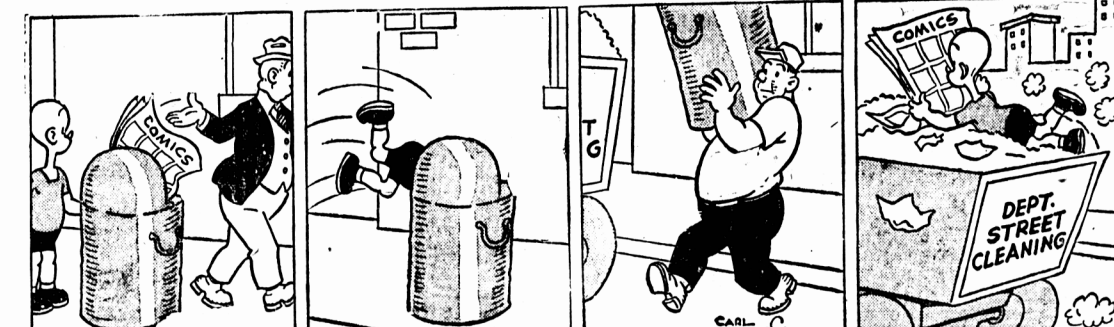

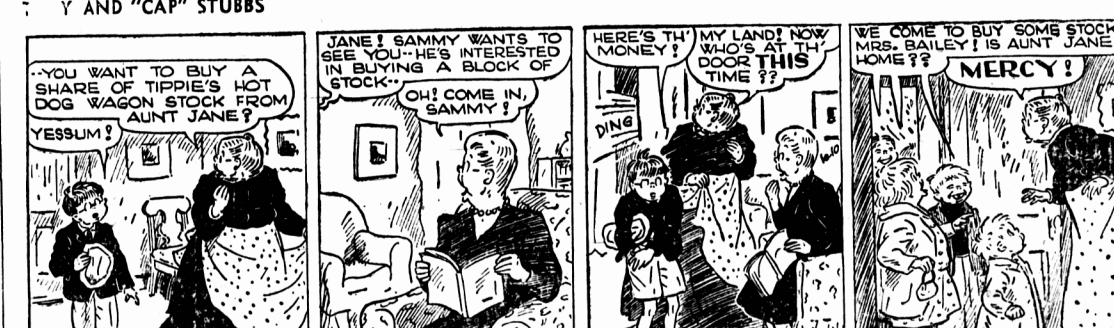
