WHY DO STARS SHOOT?

The following, taken from the January "St. Nicholas," is in answer to a subscriber's question as to why shooting-stars move:

Each so-called shooting-star is merely a cold little meteor which is moving around the sun and in its own path, just as the immensely larger comets and planets are doing. On the average these particles are moving about twenty-six miles a second when they are at the distance from the sun that the earth is, and as the earth itself is moving eighteen and one-half miles a second, the two bodies are sure to collide with each other with a high velocity.

The reason why the little meteoric particles are moving so very swiftly in the first place is simply, because they are falling toward the sun. Every world and sun attracts everything near it by virtue of the wonderful force known as "gravitation."

HOW CHLOROFORM WAS DISCOVERED

One of the most helpful discoveries ever made by men of science was that chloroform will send anyone into such a deep sleep that the surgeon can operate upon the body without pain. By the discovery of this, more than sixty years ago, men and women have ever since been saved from terrible pain that must have caused death. The doctor with whose name the discovery of this power of chloroform is always associated was Sir James Young Simpson, of Edinburgh, who first used and popularized the drug; but it is now said that the suggestion to use chloroform was made to Dr. Simpson by Dr. Waldeie, of Linlithgow, who was accidentally assisted by an inquisitive dog, a pet spaniel, belonging to his neighbor.

The neighbors were great friends when Dr. Waldeie was experimenting with chloroform and giving his results to Professor Simpson. One night, when the neighbor was leaving the doctor's house, he said: "I think my dog was with me."

"Yes," said the doctor, "and there he is," pointing to the dog lying stiff and apparently dead upon the table.

"He is dead!" exclaimed the neighbor. "No," said the doctor, examining him; "his heart beats quite strong. He has been smelling that saucer I put there for a mouse. He is quite insensible. If you cut him to pieces he would not feel it. He will come to himself in about an hour and he will be all right tomorrow. I will look in and see him."

And so it proved. Afterward, Sir James Simpson and some of his medical friends chloroformed themselves, but it was the accidental experiment of the dog Fido which led the way by showing them the power and safety of chloroform.

This year is the centenary of Dr. Waldeie's birth in Linlithgow, and it is proposed to put a bronze tablet on the house in which he lived.—Exchange.
