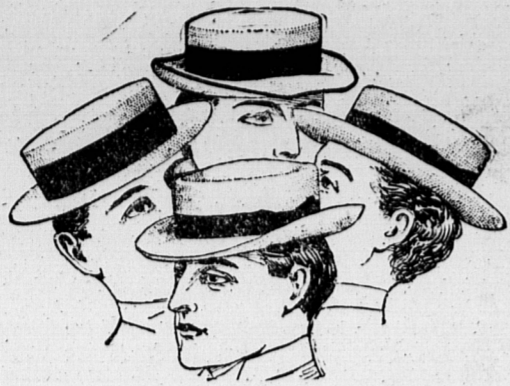

The two most versatile stars in America will be dual headliners at the Fifth Avenue Theatre during the week of May 23. He is the most sought after man in America, but his part must be agreeable, else vaudeville will hold first claim on him. Miss Bergere will attempt a superb production of Edward Weitzell's spectacular comedy-drama of circus life, "The Lion Tamer," in which she will be supported by a company of ten. The scenic effects will be marked by a careful attention to detail, and it is claimed that "The Lion Tamer" is the truest exposition yet of real circus life on the boards. Its appeal is said to be irresistible and Miss Bergere's acting will serve as an inspiration for many years to come. With consummate art, she will portray the various moods of the queen of the sawdust, playful, withal, but with an undercurrent of dramatic intensity, skilfully blended with the lighter moments. With summer on the wave, it surely will be refreshing to see Ed Wynn manipulate his big straw hat while exchanging quips with Al Lee. Wynn and Lee claim that they will present the wisest bunch of nonsense and the most nonsensical bunch of wisdom yet devised, so its up to them to demonstrate their wares to an eager public. Section IV, geology, biology, etc.: Joseph Burr Tyrrell, M.A., B.Sc., formerly of the geological survey. Confirmation of these elections, owing to the decision to postpone the annual meeting until September on account of the King's death, will have to be held over till September.

MANY KILLED AND INJURED.

CANTON, Ohio, May 18.—With a roar, heard three miles away, a battery of several boilers at the American Sheet and Tin Plate Co., exploded, killing from twenty to thirty men and injuring about fifty.

Among the injured are half a dozen who will probably die. Others the physicians say, cannot live. The cause of the explosion is unknown. The firemen and engineer, who were in the boiler room, are dead.

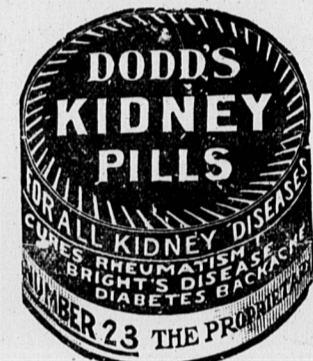
