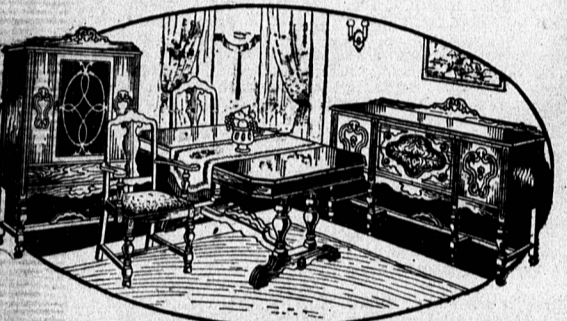

Improvement voted by Steel Companies

NEW YORK, April 30.—Sharp improvement over the first three months of last year was indicated by three steel companies reporting today for the first quarter of 1935. Although still some distance from the profit mark, United States Steel Corporation showed a sharp reduction in the size of its total deficit, from \$12,035,818 in the preceding quarter to \$3,975,208 in the quarter just closed. This compares with total deficit of \$6,791,370 in the first quarter of 1934. The 50-cent quarterly dividend on the preferred stock was maintained. Payments have been at this rate since Jan., 1933 when the dividend was cut from \$1.75. National Steel's earnings in the first quarter of \$3,367,632 equalled \$1.56 a share on the Common Stock compared with \$1,642,226, or 76 cents a share in the like period last year. Inland increased its dividend to 50 cents a share from the 25 cents a share paid in the previous three quarters. Net earnings for the quarter of \$2,465,766 equalled \$2.05 a share compared with \$1,104,337, or 92 cents a share in the March quarter of 1934.

TO RELEASE WOMEN PRISONERS

MONTREAL, April 30.—Between 300 and 400 men and women prisoners in jails of the province of Quebec will be released towards the end of this week as a result of the general reduction of sentences granted in celebration of the Silver Jubilee of King George. It is estimated by officials of the Prisoners' Aid and Welfare Association here.

Clearance Sale In Beverages Announced

HALIFAX, April 30.—The fee for a liquor permit in Nova Scotia will be reduced tomorrow from \$1 to 25 cents, Chairman C. W. Ackhurst of the Liquor Commission announced today. At the same time, he disclosed, prices in about 20 lines of spirits and wines in stock since 1930 will drop below manufacturers prices in order to clear them away for new stock. The reductions range from 50 cents to \$1 on spirits and average 50 cents per quart of wine. In some cases, wine prices are slashed 65 percent. The "clearance sale" is being held to make way for stock purchased under reduced customs and excise taxes, which also will be sold at lowered prices.

Four Injured In Bomb Blast

VIENNA, April 30.—Four persons were injured tonight as the result of a bomb in front of a precinct police station touched off the radical observance of May day in the workers' quarters of the city. Dr. Thannhofer, secretary of the federal chancellery, who happened to be nearby, had his legs torn off by the bomb. Police attributed the first bombing in Vienna in many months to Communists. Graveyards will be locked and barred and the sale of flowers forbidden during tomorrow's May Day celebration here to forestall demonstrations at the graves of socialist dead.

New Invincible Lifeboat Is Given Trial

SANDY HOOK, N. J., April 30.—The largest lifeboat in the world is looking for trouble in the North Atlantic today. The Invincible, equipped with modern rescue facilities as well as apparatus to prevent tipping, left here yesterday on a week's test cruise during which it will point for any storms reported. It carries a crew of six, in addition to four district commanders who will determine if claims made for it are feasible in rescue conditions. The craft, which cost the United States government \$100,000, was designed to lower the death toll in sea accidents where small boats are forced to return to shore with their rescued persons. The Invincible has a capacity of 100 persons.

Mme. Stavisky Released From Prison

PARIS, April 30.—Madame Stavisky, the late big-time French swindler, today was granted her provisional liberty after more than a year in jail. Her release was in answer to several requests which she made on the grounds that the charges against her in connection with her husband's operations were not serious enough to keep her in prison while awaiting trial. Madame Stavisky said she intended rejoining her children.
