

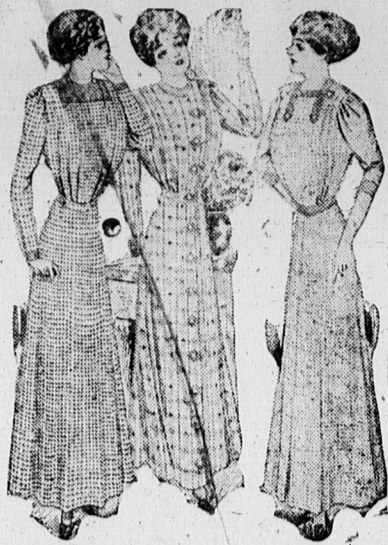

TERRIBLE DISASTER ENDS BALL

MATEISALKA, Hungary, March 29.—The death list in the ball-room ho. locaust now largely exceeds three hundred, and may reach four hundred, while a very large number of other persons were seriously injured. It appears that such a crowd endeavored to gain admittance to the ball-room that the one door was nailed up when the building was filled to prevent its overcrowding. A branch of dry spruce caught fire from a Chinese lantern and instantly the whole building was in flames. The women with gowns ablaze ran through the room shrieking "Fire." Everywhere the dancers all crowded toward the door, but those in front, who endeavored to tear down the boards blocking the exit were trampled by the frantic men and women behind. When the door was finally broken open a few escaped. Inside the building were heaps of charred corpses and screams and groans are still audible from the smouldering pile of humanity.

A HERO DEAD.

HALIFAX, March 29.—Father Me-Isaac, hero of the cholera epidemic in the ship "England," which arrived here from Europe in 1865 with a large number of immigrants, died at Mount St. Vincent yesterday, in the ninetyeth year of his age. He had been in the priesthood sixty-five years, and had been stationed in every Diocese in this Province.

BUSY TIMES AT THE PORTS OF ST. JOHN AND HALIFAX.

MONTREAL, March 29.—Advice received by the railroad companies show that the present week will be a record breaker in immigration. Twelve thousand immigrants will be landed at St. John and Halifax during the week ending Saturday.

BOSTON & MAINE ROAD ENJOINED FROM INCREASING RATES

EXETER, N. H., March 28.—A temporary injunction restraining the Boston & Maine Railroad Company from further raising its freight rates was granted by Justice William A. Plummer of the Superior Court here today, upon petition of Attorney-General Edwin Eastman. The question of making the injunction permanent will come up at the April term of the Superior Court at Exeter, beginning the third Tuesday in April. This action follows the efforts of the attorney general to have many of the railroad's present rates declared illegal and the road prevented from making further advances, on the ground that the legislative acts permitting the Boston & Maine to place several of its subsidiary lines in this state prohibited the road from increasing any of the freight rates in effect at the time of leasing. The railroad company in its arguments made up at the April term of the Superior Court had lapsed through non-enforcement.

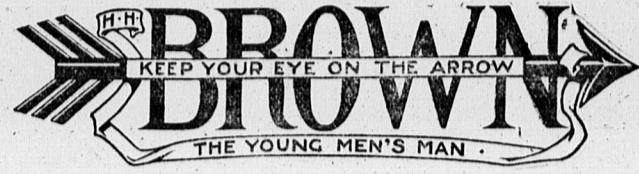

COAL AGENCY COMPANY GOES INTO LIQUIDATION.

NEW YORK, March 29.—Being unable to meet its obligations the Canadian Consolidated Mines Co., Ltd., with offices in this city, and an authorized capital of \$5,000,000, holding agency for several coal mining companies in New Brunswick and Nova Scotia, was placed in the hands of a receiver yesterday. Its liabilities are \$50,000; assets not announced.

CALGARY CONCERN TAKEN INTO BIG CEMENT MERGER.

MONTREAL, March 28.—A settlement was arrived at yesterday regarding the difficulties experienced in getting the Esshaw Cement Company of Calgary into the big cement merger. For a long time there was an acute difference of opinion between the two parties, and all sorts of litigation was threatened. It is stated that the settlement terms comprise the substitution of one five per cent bond issue for the first and second mortgage bond issues, as at first proposed. A re-arrangement of the company's liabilities has also been agreed to, and it is understood the Calgary company enters the merger on terms satisfactory all round.

A WHITE YOGI AT THE EDEN MUSEUM.

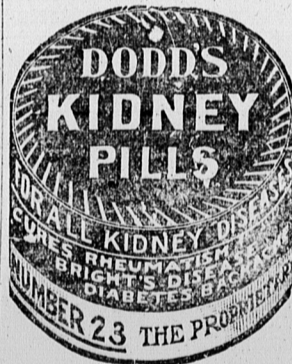
Many of the world's famous magicians have made their first appearance in this country at the Eden Museum of New York City. 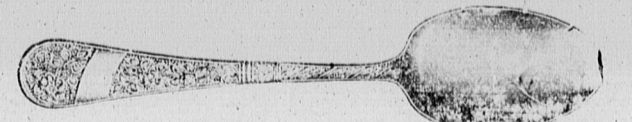

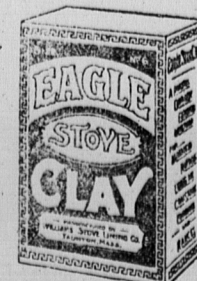
