Fisher Sits on War Council

LONDON, March 9.—For the first time since he left the Admiralty, Lord Fisher, former First Sea Lord, today attended a full meeting of the war council, presided over by premier Asquith. The invitation to Lord Fisher to attend the council was extended more than a week ago and had nothing to do with the speech in the House of Commons yesterday of Col. Winston Spencer Churchill, former First Lord of the Admiralty, who said Lord Fisher should be brought back to head the Admiralty administration. It is understood Lord Fisher was invited to join the war council temporarily, to give his advice on important matters in regard to which his experience would be useful. It is not believed to be likely that he will return to the Admiralty as a permanent member.

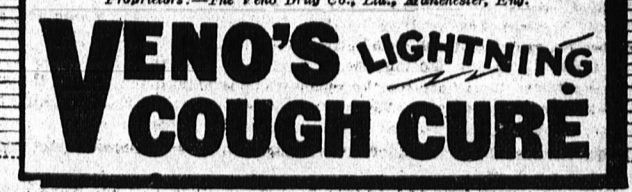
