Hungary—And Her Wheat—Fit Into German Expansion Plans

Pre-War Link Strengthened In New Crisis

BY WILLIS THORNTON NEA Service Staff Correspondent As one of the "have-not" powers, hounded and discredited by the World War Settlement, Hungary has been a natural sympathizer with much of the program which Chancellor Hitler has put in action in Germany.



After the World War, Hungary was reduced to one-third of her pre-war size by the Allies. Predominantly agricultural, Hungary is just what Germany needs to feed her industrialized population.

GERMANS ARE PROBLEMS, TOO

Germany could help Hungary materially in getting back lands and minorities lost to Czechoslovakia and Rumania. On the other hand, Hungary has 8,000,000 vociferous Germans, many of them active Nazis, who carry on just such a campaign as the Sudeten Germans did in Czechoslovakia.

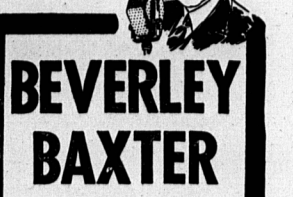

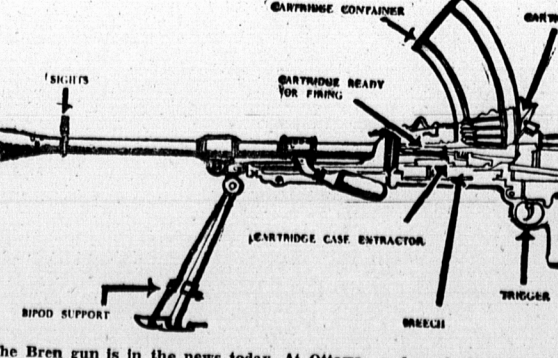

The Bren gun is in the news today. At Ottawa, a formal investigation into the contracts dealing with the manufacture of this weapon in Canada is under way as the result of a certain magazine article. Several facts concerning the gun were disclosed at today's hearing. The gun weighs 21 pounds and each magazine contains 30 rounds of ammunition. The contents of a magazine are fired at the rate of 450 to 500 rounds a minute. With an experienced crew, magazine changes can be made quickly enough to make an operating rate of fire of 210 rounds a minute. The gun contains 161 component parts and something over 3,000 operations are required in factory production. The range is about 1,000 yards. There are two barrels with each gun; when the first barrel gets overheated you start on the spare one. The Bren got its name from two towns, Brno, in Czechoslovakia, where it was first made, and Enfield, England, where it is now made.
