P.E. ISLAND DEAR TO SOLDIERS IN FRANCE

The following letter has been received by Miss Sarah Wilson, of Southampton, from her brother, Sergt. James J. Wilson, at the front:

Somewhere in France, August 30, 1916.

Dear Sister Sarah—Just a line to let you know that I am well, and received your letter some time ago, but could not get time to write, as I have been very busy for the last few days. We just finished a three days' march a couple of days ago. It was very all footsore and tired. It rained nearly all the time we were marching, so it was not very pleasant.

We are settled down to work now, and we are all kept busy all the time, besides going on parade. I am orderly sergeant, which keeps me on the jump most of the time. We have very good billets here. I sleep in a manger and it beats all the springs and mattresses ever slept on. You might think that a cow stable would not be a nice place to live in, but this one has white-washed walls and brick floor; besides it is very convenient to be able to sit on my manger and eat off the table.

The country is very pretty around here, and our route of march. The harvest is all in stock. This is a fine farming country, but I would rather have a farm in the blueberry district in dear old P. E. Island. We will not be here very long, I expect.

We want to get back to the trenches when we are out for twelve days. We may get some real hard fighting yet before the war ends, and the end will come sooner now with Roumania on our side, and Greece will likely come in, too. This is some war all right. We will not forget for some time. If God wishes me for the next two months, I shall hope to see you all again. I have been very lucky so far. I believe it is the prayers of you at home that saved me, and perhaps I may need them more than ever very soon. The cigarettes you sent never reached me yet. Please don't bother sending any more. I can buy them cheaper than you can over home. You will soon be going back to Yankee land. Hope you all have a good time at home. I may be home a year from now. Still life is not very certain here, but don't worry about me, for I don't worry about the future. With love to father, mother and you all. From your loving brother, JIMMIE.

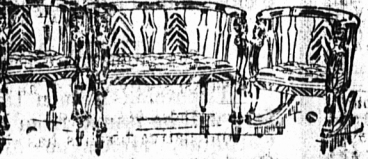

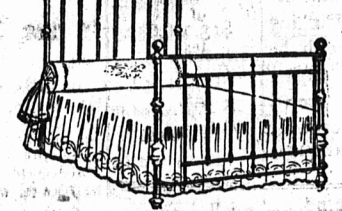
