SEMI-annual examination was held in the Pownal school on Monday, 23rd inst. The school had been nicely decorated by the pupils. The room was well filled with happy looking children, showing by their smiling faces that they did not dread the coming ordeal. A goodly number of parents and visitors arriving added to the interest of the occasion. Among those present were: Mrs. (Rev.) Spurr, Rev. Mr. Opie, Capt. Jones, J. Walter Jones of Acadia College, Mr. Hubley, teacher in the school for the blind, Halifax; Master Vernon Jones, do; Mr. A. P. Ings, Mr. David Jones, Trustees: Messrs. A. A. A. A. Moore and A. Gay. Mr. Moore examined some of the junior classes in reading, spelling etc. Mrs. Spurr and Capt. Jones the advanced classes in reading and etc. Mr. Walter Jones and the teacher examined the classes in geography and history. The junior classes were examined in mental arithmetic by the teacher, and the senior class by Master Vernon Jones. The reading and spelling of the 4th and 5th classes was exceptionally good, showing careful training. The simultaneous reciting by the 4th class of "Love of Country" was faultless. In history and geography the pupils acquitted themselves admirably. In mental arithmetic it was pleasing to hear the little ones adding up the numbers given so quickly, but it was when Vernon Jones stood up to examine the 5th class that excitement ran high and breathless silence reigned, as it is well known that mental work is a leading feature in the education of the blind. He started in moderately with sums about half a yard long to add, subtract, divide and multiply and getting correct answers promptly. He became exacting and gave (as he thought) a knockout sum calling the numbers out so fast that none but a lightning calculator could follow him; but no sooner was he done than Master Stanley Opie gave the answer amid the applause of all present, and the hearty good well done from Master Vernon Jones. Then followed a speech by Rev. Mr. Opie in his fluent and pleasing manner. He spoke at some length expressing pleasure at being present, and pleased with the examination, believed that good work was being done. Mr. Hubley in a lengthy speech highly praised the teacher and the pupils on the good showing, specially congratulating Stanley Opie on his mental ability and giving good advice to the pupils in general. Speeches were made by Capt. Jones, Walter and Vernon Jones, A. A. Moore, A. Gay, A. P. Ings, and others, all speaking in flattering terms of Miss Spurr's ability as a teacher. Miss Spurr suitably acknowledged the kind words spoken, when to the delight of the children she presented each of the pupils present and absent with a large package of candy and apples. Singing God Save the King, and three cheers and a tiger form the children, brought this most successful examination to a close.
