FLY FISHING IN IRELAND

DUBLIN, March 30.—The fishing season is just at hand and fine sport is anticipated in most parts of Ireland, more especially in the south, where houses on the beautiful Blackwater are letting well. Ireland produces some of the finest trout and salmon fishing in the world. Curious to relate, fish in Irish streams are "cuter" than in any others, thus it will be little avail to the would-be sportsman to bring with him a supply of flies which "kill" successfully in other regions. If he is foolish enough to do so he may angle all day long and never find a trout—not to say salmon—at the end of his line. Almost every river in Ireland has its own special flies, although, for instance, the Blackwater and the Gradogue are within a few miles of each other, a fly that will kill splendidly on one is of no use on the other. In most of the villages there is one great authority on the fly that will do good work on any stream in the neighborhood. He makes and sells flies and can tell everything about the river and is altogether regarded as a "specialist" in his line and commands a position of considerable interest inasmuch as every fisherman who comes to the neighborhood consults him. He is taken out for a day's sport with the best in the land, because of the information he is in a position to give. The most of the Irish streams are free for trout fishing—that is to say not preserved—and anyone can fish therein without paying a tax. Netting is, of course, a criminal offence and so is spearing trout, but on the whole there is very little of this done. The Irish are born sportsmen and despise any methods contrary to orthodox ways, so the typical fisherman would no more think of netting his trout than a good "shot" would fire at a bird which is sitting.

AUTOMATIC ALARMS.

The concussion caused by the plunger striking violently this false door causes this powerful alarm bell on top of the Indicator case to ring loudly for the space of five minutes and if necessary this powerful alarm bell can be made to ring for half an hour or even more if required. There is a dial on the face of the Indicator and by going to the office of the hotel, it can be told at once in what particular room the fire is. Hotels and private houses having one of Eaton's Automatic Fire Alarms installed therein are in no danger of having the guests or residents burnt up alive while sleeping calmly in their beds, all unaware of danger.
