A DECORATION FOR NEWCOMB

The Kaiser Confers Pour le Merite on the American for Greatness in Science. Professor Well Known in P. E. Island.

NEW YORK, Aug. 14.—Prof. Simon Newcomb is about to receive from the German emperor the order which Congress recently authorized him to accept. The Kaiser has decided to confer upon the eminent astronomer and scientist the order "pour le merite," (freely for merit in science and art). It is one of the highest independent honors in the gift of the Kaiser and has been worn by the world's greatest scientist in several generations, inasmuch as Germany has for years been in the forefront of scientific progress. Prof. Newcomb is the only American authorized to accept the decoration of a foreign monarch in eight years, and has, indeed, received more of these honors than any other living American. He is an officer of the Legion of Honor, is the first native of America since Franklin to be made an associate of the Institute of France, has received exalted degrees from ten European universities, is a member of about thirty foreign societies, has received five medals from abroad, had his portrait ordered by the czar for the Imperial university of Russia while both the Imperial university of Japan and the Imperial observatory of Russia have presented him with handsome testimonial vases in recognition of his contributions to science. (It may not be generally known that Prof. Newcomb's father taught school near Summerside also in or near Kensington and in other places on this Province. There are persons in Summerside who were his school-mates and play-fellows. He paid a visit to this Province a few years ago, sought out his old friends and

spent a day or two with them. He gave with his own hand a work of his on astronomy and has corresponded with one of his friends in Summerside since his visit.)

ENGINEERS OF WIDE REPUTATION

Three Distinguished Experts Appointed to Prepare Plans for Quebec Bridge.

OTTAWA, Aug. 14.—At this afternoon's concluding meeting of the Cabinet Council for this month an Order-in-Council was passed approving of the appointment of Henry H. Vautlet, C. E., of Montreal; Maurice Fitzmaurice, C. M. G. of London, England; and Ralph Mojeski of Chicago as a board of expert bridge engineers to prepare plans for the reconstruction of the Quebec Bridge. The engineers selected for the work are the best available in Canada, Great Britain and the United States. The Canadian representative, Mr. Vautlet, who will be chairman of the Board is a member of the Canadian Society of Civil Engineers, and until recently was in general practice at Montreal as consulting engineer. He was for some years bridge engineer for the Canadian Pacific.
