Mrs. J. R. CURRIE'S funeral from her late home No 167 Charlotte street this afternoon was very largely attended. Gates of Germain street Baptist church conducted the solemn ceremonies at the house, also at the graveside in Fernhill. The Germain street church quartette, Messrs. Titus, Archie Cook, George Parker and Herbert Mayes rendered several very appropriate hymns. Notable among the floral tokens of loving remembrance and sincere respect was the piece here described from the pupils of the C. B. U. — A large standing harp almost four feet high with one broken cord. The piece was very handsome and standing on a base of polished ivory and white ferns. It was composed of white roses, azalias, fresas and ferns. The bottom part of the harp was made up of pink roses, hyacinths and ferns and on one side of the top a large bow and end of white satin ribbon, inscribed as follows, "With sympathy of the students of Currie's Business University." Crescent of white roses, azalias, hyacinths, frosia and ferns, from Mr. and Mrs. J. S. Currie. Crescent of white roses, carnations, azalias, narcissus, lily of the valley, asparagus and smilax, from Mrs. and Miss P. Clark."

The foregoing report of the funeral of the late Mrs. Currie, wife of Mr. J. R. Currie, Principal of Currie's Business University of St. John, N. B., is taken from the St. John Record. Mr. Currie and his brother, Mr. John D., an assistant in the College are sons of Mr. L. Currie, postmaster of Little Sinds, P. E. I. Messrs. Currie have been very successful in their work in St. John and have now 215 students. 41 having been added to the list during the past month. They are respected citizens of St. John and as a home has been saddened, much sympathy will be felt for the bereaved.
