FINANCE

NEW YORK, April 10—(AP)—Leading stocks put a feeble foot forward in today's early market proceedings but initial fractional rallies were reduced or cancelled in many cases at the finish. Losers among Canadian issues included Walkers, Lake Shore Mines, Ford and Marconi. Distillers Stearns and Dome Mines were steady. The Associated Press average of 60 stocks was off 1 of a point at 40 1/2, the smallest decline of the week. It was the sixth consecutive session in which the composite was on the losing side; today's closing figures compared with a 1941 high of 48 and a low of 30 3/4. A year ago the average stood at 50 3/4. Transfers amounted to 337,230 shares against 584,020 yesterday. U.S. Steel ended up 1-4 of a point as the company announced March shipments of finished products established a new peak. Bethlehem, though, was off 1-4 and Youngstown Steel, a full point. Emerging behind minus signs were Chrysler, American Smelting, Montgomery Ward, Douglas Aircraft, United Aircraft, Eastman Kodak, Du Pont, U.S. Gypsum, American Telephone, Western Union, Consolidated Edison and International Harvester.

Toronto Exchange

TORONTO, April 10—(CP)—Trading in the highest volume of the year for a full session, the Toronto stock market continued the downward drift today. Only 108,000 shares changed hands. McIntyre weakened 1-2 and Hollinger 1-8 and losses of 4 to 7 cents were showing at the close for Anor, Cochenour, Kerr-Addison, Little Long Lac, Pickle Crow, Preston and Sturgeon. River and the close was down 10 to 20 cents for Wright-Hargreaves, Bralorne and Lamaque. Prices closed narrowly higher for Macassa, MacLeod, Pamour, San Antonio, Sylvanite and Inspiration. International Nickel declined a point to close at 32 1-2 and Hudson Bay weakened 1-4 to 23 1-4. Noranda held unchanged and Steep Rock came up 5 cents to 1.01. Utilities leaned to the down side, posting a point decline for Montreal Power and 7 1-2 points to 80 for Gattineau Power pfd. Kelvinator weakened 1 3-4 to 9 1-4. Canadian General Electric 5 to 210, International Metals A pfd 6 1-2 to 93 1-2 and National Steel Car a point to 33. Several Industrials, including Burlington Steel, Imperial Oil, Simpsons B. Union Gas and Walkers common, held moderate gains. Changes in the western oils were limited to a loss of a cent to 1 1/2 for Home Oil. Homestead firmed 1-4 to 2.
