Losses Have Slight Lead Over Gains
Little Recovery is Noted On Market

NEW YORK, Oct. 18 - (AP) - Scattered stocks made a little progress on the recovery side today while many market leaders were neglected in slightly lower territory. Transfers of 820,000 shares compared with 1,310,000 Thursday and were the smallest since Oct. 3. The Associated Press 60-stock composite was unchanged at 63.1. Retaining improvement of a point each were Youngstown Sheet, at 66 1-2 Hiram Walker at 115, American Smelting at 33, Du Pont at 178 1-2 and Allied Chemical at 180 1-2. Lesser advances were shown for U.S. Steel, Republic Steel, Goodrich, Goodyear, Oliver Corp. International Harvester, Consolidated Edison, North American, Anaconda, Southern Pacific, Chesapeake and Ohio and Standard Oil (N.J.). U.S. Gypsum was off 3 at 108 1-2. Johns-Manville 2 at 129, Eastman Kodak 1 at 210 and Bethlehem 1 at 129. Hamilton and Dominion Bridges, M. Locomotive, U. Steel, C. Industries, C. Car "A", Cement and Foundation, Celanese dropped a rise in textiles. Walker and Seagrams pushed up in beverages and C. Brewer's wiped out a deficit. Brazilian and Jamaica advanced on improvements in utilities and lagging were Bell Winnipeg Electric, Shawinigan and Montreal, Quebec, International, C.N. and S.C. Powers. Montreal and Royal were easier in banks. Steamship firm in carriers, O.P.R. inched down and Provincial Transport recovered from a stumble. Aluminum advanced in metals and Nickel and Smelters were down for a time. Imperial was up and Petroleum and E.A. pointed down in oil. Header in junior mines were Buffalo, Central Cadillac, Soma and Nechi. Pitt did not retain an increase. In loss territory were Wright-Hargreaves, Elgin, Eastman, Alskicho, O'Brien, Santiago, Sloose, Lovvournt, Sherritt, Normetals and Elder. Slipping in miscellaneous were Tobacco, Lake of the Woods, St. Lawrence Flour, Wilsit, Lumber, Paul and Chemicals. Weston worked up. Trading box score: Total sales, 172,600 shares; mines, 125,200; distillates, 49,400; stocks, 10,600; higher 50; unchanged 53; new highs 2; new lows 7.

British Councils Ask for Analysis of Their Status

LONDON, Oct. 18 - (CP) - Representatives of Britain's 10,000 local governments fear their responsibilities and powers are being removed through central government orders but Health Minister Bevan has told them this is not the time for an inquiry into the system. Appearing before the Association of Municipal Corporations, Mr. Bevan said he knew many members of local authorities thought urgent legislative measures would decentralize local government. However, the central government hoped that functions of local government would be enlarged, although some services had been nationalized and others might be, and instruments other than local authorities had to be used. The society in which local authorities function is undergoing enormous changes, he said, and the first investigation must be into the kind of society in which they are to operate. Having heard this opinion, the Association later carried unanimously a resolution asking that its general purpose committee give urgent consideration to the existing structure of local government in the light of recent and pending legislation. The resolution expressed concern over piecemeal legislation which was removing the powers and responsibilities of municipal authorities and indicated faith in local government based on democratic principles. National Planning Changes in local government structure were indicated years ago when central authorities accepted the chief responsibility for outlays such as unemployment relief and

ECCLÉS CAKE
Roll pastry into a thin rectangular sheet. Cover half the sheet with a layer of currants. Sprinkle the currants with sugar and a very little finely chopped suet and some lemon rind. Wet the edges of the paste. Cover the filling with the other half of the paste and press the edges. Place in a shallow pan. Score the surface of the cake with inch lines about 1/2 inch apart in both directions. Bake in a 425 deg. F. oven approximately 15 minutes.
