DUELS AMONG SUDANESE ARABS.

Where Pastoral Life Doesn't Always Lead to Peace and Quiet. The country to the southeast of Tshar, in Africa, is the home of the Haas; the Hadendosa occupy the hours to the south and the plateau to the southwest. Both of these are black Arabs, speaking different languages. The Haas live almost entirely on sour milk, while the Hadendosa are agricultural as well as pastoral. Phenomena Awe Europe.

Europe and Asia were covered by fog during the summer of 1783. Says Gilbert White (letter 108): "The summer of the year 1783 was an amazing and portentous one. . . for, besides the alarming meteors and tremendous thunderstorms, the peculiar haze, or smoky fog, that prevailed for many weeks in this island (England) and in every part of Europe, and even beyond its limits, was a most extraordinary appearance. The heat was intense. Calabria and part of the Isle of Sicily were torn and convulsed with earthquakes. Cowper also refers to this phenomenon, in speaking of "nature, with a dim and sticky eye."
