Flour Prices Are Dropping

WINNIPEG, Sept. 27.—With wheat on the decline flour is due for a further decline in price, according to the local millers. Western millers commenced August 30th to mill 1920 crop. Practically all the stocks in Western Canada of war grade of flour have been disposed of and pre-war grade of flour at \$9.37 1/2 as compared with \$7.15 under Government control of wheat. Retail grocers on Saturday sold at 98c a pound pre-war grade flour \$7.75.

Two Tragic Deaths in Montreal

MONTREAL, Sept. 27.—With a bullet through the brain the body of Pit Peigeon, 450 Frontenac Lane, was found on a bed when the occupants of the house rushed to his room, after hearing a pistol shot this afternoon.
Fannie Schuckman, aged six was struck and run over by an automobile truck near Descairieres on Saturday night and sustained a crushed chest and fractured leg and died at the Hotel Dia Hospital later.

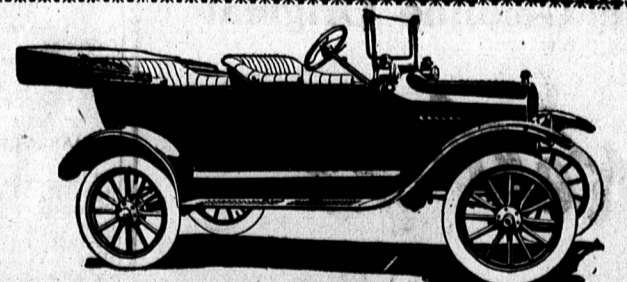
Lowered Four World's Records

SPRINGFIELD, Mass., Sept. 25.—Leon Duray, the French automobile driver, before a crowd of 18,000 people at the Eastern States Exposition track, this afternoon lowered four world's records. Duray raced his car around the saucer in the mile, in the record time of 1.03, hanging up the three, four and five mile marks all on the same trip. His time for three miles was 3.10 2-5, four 4.13 and five 5.50 3-5.
