Wall Street Not Affected By Death Of Ivan Kreuger

NEW YORK, N. Y., Mar. 14—Wall Street leaders viewed the situation arising from the death of Ivar Kreuger today as of little direct bearing upon financial affairs in the United States.

Bankers acknowledged that the psychological effect upon world financial centres was undoubtedly adverse, but it was believed neither Kreuger nor the Kreuger Companies had outstanding bank loans in the United States.

Officers of Lee, Higginson and Co., New York banking representatives of Kreuger and Toll Co., were kept open during the day, while some of the partners met to receive any further advices from Stockholm.

YOUTH CAST ASIDE PETER PAN IS WED

LONDON, March 14—"Peter Pan" has grown up and was married to-day.

Peter Llewellyn Davies, credited with being the inspiration for Sir James M. Barrie's "Peter Pan," was married at the Savoy chapel to the Hon. Margaret Leslie Hore-Ruthven, daughter of Major-General Lord Ruthven.

Barrie attended the ceremony. Davies is a godson of the famous author. Thirty years ago, just before "Peter Pan" was written, Barrie used to play pirate games with Peter and his four brothers at the Barrie country home near Farnham. All five boys were sons of Sylvia and Arthur Llewellyn Davies, daughter and son-in-law of George Du Maurier, author of "Trilby."

Half-Million Honor Apostle Of Peace

PARIS, Mar. 14—(A. P.)—The world and his homeland gave final honors Saturday to Aristide Briand. Half a million persons lined the streets of Paris as his body was borne from the foreign office, over which he presided so many years, to Passy Cemetery.

Because Briand was the "Apostle of Peace" he was accorded a peace lover's funeral. Instead of the usual gun carriage, an ordinary horse drawn coach bore him to his grave, and the part played by the military arm of the nation was cut to the minimum.

The half million, massed the length of the majestic Champs Elysees, stood bare-headed and watched the hearse go slowly by. At the end of the cortege a delegation of war veterans displayed a placard on which was inscribed Briand's famous utterance welcoming Germany into the League of Nations: "Away with cannon and guns!"

That phrase caught the imagination of the throng. At first timidly and then wholeheartedly, men, women, and children clapped their hands.

Although the army in a brief but impressive march past his coffin at the foreign office honored the Premier who defended Verdun and who organized the Salonika expedition, it was the common people who formed the procession that followed Briand to the grave.

Swedish Match King A Suicide

STOCKHOLM, Sweden March 14—(A. P.)—Both chambers of the Swedish Riksdag today adopted a bill authorizing the government to grant companies or persons a short moratorium on payment of debts.

Minister of Finance Felix Hamrin opened the debate in the upper chamber and emphasized that the powers conferred in the measure would be employed with the utmost caution and with respect to national as well as private interests.

Socialist Deputy Moeller replied that although parliament had granted vast powers it did not intend to forego the right to criticize whatever measures the government should take.
