Presentation to Her Excellency the Lady Byng of Vimy

Mrs. Heartz and Mrs. J.D. Stewart have received communications from Madame Lapointe, wife of the Minister of Justice at Ottawa, on behalf of a Committee of which Mrs. (Dr.) J.H. King, wife of the Minister of Public Works at Ottawa is Treasurer, which read in part as follows:

"Realizing the desire of the people of Canada to make a presentation to Her Excellency the Lady Byng of Vimy, prior to her leaving a few of the wives of the public men met recently to consider the best means of raising the necessary funds. A Central Organization Committee was formed at Ottawa, and feeling assured that the wives of the Lieutenant Governors and Premiers would gladly co-operate to make the farrow gift to Lady Byng the gift of every part of Canada, it was decided to ask them to undertake the organization and collection of subscriptions within their respective Provinces. Lord and Lady Byng are so much loved by the Canadian people that all those who can possibly do so will want to subscribe, and it should be made well understood that all subscriptions, however small, will be welcomed from every one and much appreciated."

In connection with the above request Mrs. Heartz and Mrs. Stewart have consulted with the Presidents of several of the Women's Organizations and they are willing to put the matter before their Societies and out-of-town Branches.

It is hoped that all, both Men's Societies and Women's Societies, who may not have been approached in the matter will interest themselves and contribute either as Societies or as individuals, for this is to be the gift of every part of Canada, and all subscriptions, however small will be welcomed from everybody.

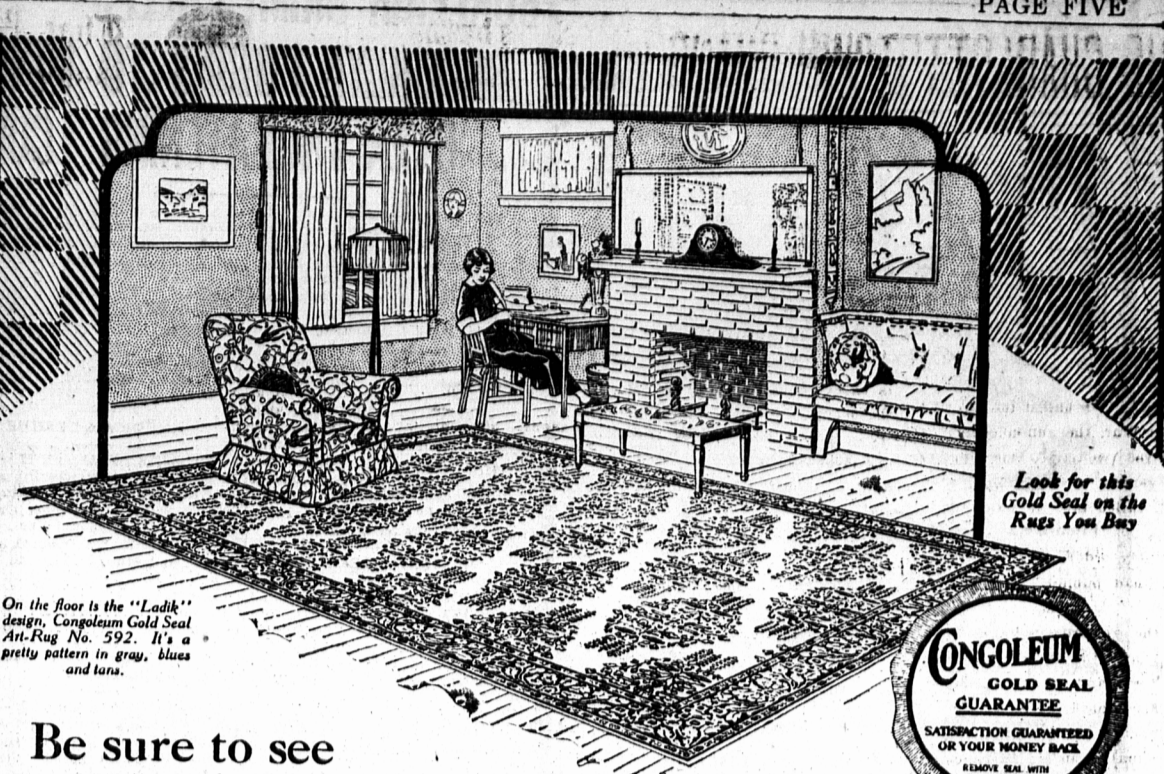
