THE COOK'S CORNER

BANANA LEMON FILLING
 1-4 cup sugar
 3 tablespoons flour
 1-8 teaspoon salt
 1 cup milk
 1 egg
 2 teaspoons lemon juice
 Grated rind of 1 lemon
 1 cup finely sliced bananas

Method: Mix together the sugar, flour and salt in the top part of a double boiler. Place over boiling water and add the milk gradually. Cook the mixture, stirring constantly, until thickened and no raw taste of flour remains. Beat the egg thoroughly and add a little of the cooked mixture to it, then return this to the double boiler and cook for about a minute longer, stirring constantly. Remove from the heat, add the lemon juice and grated rind and the sliced bananas thoroughly and spread filling on prepared cake.

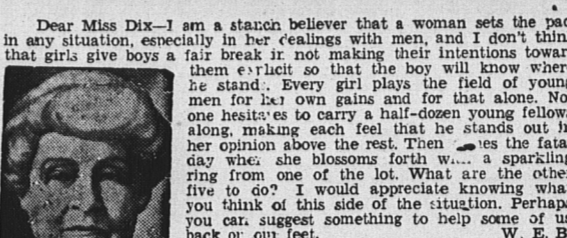
BANANA LEMON ROLL
 3 egg yolks beaten lightly
 3-4 cup sugar
 1 tablespoon cold water
 Grated rind of 1 lemon
 1 tablespoon lemon juice
 2-3 cup sifted cake flour
 1 teaspoon baking powder
 1-4 teaspoon salt
 3 egg whites beaten
 Banana lemon filling
 Icing sugar

Method: Beat the egg yolks until thick and lemon-colored, then gradually beat in the sugar. Add the cold water, grated lemon rind and lemon juice, the flour, then measure it and sift again with the baking powder and salt. Fold this into the egg yolk mixture, a small amount at a time. Beat the egg whites until stiff, but not dry, and fold these into the mixture also. Turn into a greased shallow pan lined with heavy paper and again greased. Bake in a moderate oven (350 deg. F) for about 20 minutes. Turn out on a sheet of waxed paper or cloth, and cut into rolls. Sprinkle with icing sugar, remove the paper quickly from the bottom of the cake and trim off the crusty edges. Spread the cake with the banana lemon filling and roll up. Wrap in wax paper to chill. Cut in 1-2-inch slices to serve, and garnish with whipped cream or ice-cream soda.
