Recent lessons, as well as the one for today, call attention to the characters and doings of young men of the highest rank and quality. Daniel and his companions, Ezra and Nehemiah, were physical and mental superiors. Their patriotism and piety were rather the outcome and expression of their mental capacity. Brains count.

taught, and none but the Holy Spirit can interpret it. But there are reverential forms of prayer upon which one cannot proceed without reaching the door of blessing. It is well to study such forms and the substance that inheres. The prayer of Nehemiah is an example.

Observe the solemn, challenging note of reverential approach unto God with which it opens. Recall that Nehemiah was surrounded by those who worshipped the natural forces which the sun and moon and stars represent, and the fuller meaning of verse five will appear.

There follows a personal plea to be heard and the reasons for it in the confession which is made. Supplication—the great matter upon his heart—Nehemiah voices while pleading the promises of God Himself. Finally, he leaves everything to the solution of the Divine mercy.

Would you pray? Do you pray? Is there the great thing that you would ask of God in prayer? The sum of the teaching of the prayer in the lesson is: 1. Plead the promises. 2. Trust to His mercy. It endures forever.
