start in the House of Commons
with Hon. J. Earl Lawson (Con.
York West) leading off as finan-
cial critic for the opposition.

New Housing Plan Not For Auto Owners

OTTAWA, June 17—(C.P.)—Oc-
cupants of the new low-cost, low-
rental housing erected under housing
Bill now before the House of
Commons are not expected to be
automobile owners, Finance Minister
Dunning told the House today
as the bill was considered in com-
mittee of the whole.

Denton Massey (Con. Toronto
Greenwood) has asked if garages
would be built in conjunction with
the housing units but Mr. Dunning
said it hadn't been considered.

Where the government was subsid-
izing housing for the benefit of
people who were unable to pay an
economic rent the minister did not
think garages should or need be
provided. Provision could be made
for commercial space in such hous-
ing projects where stores and shops
might be carried on.

The House made good progress
in approving the bill clause by
clause. All of part one, which re-
places the present housing act and
deals with loans to owners of prop-
erty, was approved. The measure
would have priority claims on the
property. In Quebec, he said, mun-
icipal and school taxes and church
assessments are levied on the prop-
erty.

Mr. Dunning said provisions in
the present act covering this aspect
were the same as in the existing
Dominion Housing Act, and no dif-
ficulties had arisen from it. There
was no intention nor would it be
valid to set mortgages under this
act ahead of municipal taxes.

Mr. Heaps (C.P. Winnipeg
North) complained of a circum-
stance arising in Winnipeg under
the Dominion Housing Act in which
a borrower was liable to lose his
title to a residence if he once de-
faulted a monthly payment.

There was an important point
in the bill providing \$20
and expending to loaning company
negotiating a loan at a point dis-
tant from its office. The expense
provision would be open to great
abuse.

Mr. Dunning said there were
many districts such as Gaspe, Que.,
and Chateaux, Ont., in which it
was impossible to charge a loan be-
cause of the expense of investiga-
tion. It was not proposed the gov-
ernment would pay expenses of an
investigation to clear up the loan
but arrangements would be
made where a number of loans
were to be made.

UNITED CANADA LEAGUE

(C. P. by Guardian's Special Wire)
OTTAWA, June 17—The Cana-
dian Gazette today disclosed in-
formation of the United Canada
League which has as its purpose
"to uphold justice, freedom, con-
stitutional and democratic govern-
ment and the welfare of the peo-
ple of Canada, preaching loyalty
to the Crown, as the tangible link
which binds all British subjects in
one common brotherhood."

JAPAN OFFERS CO-OPERATION WITH BRITAIN

Also Extends Olive
Branch To Soviet
Russia—Assails
France.

(C. P. by Guardian's Special Wire)
TOKYO, June 17—Japan tonight
offered a hand of cooperation to
Great Britain and an olive branch
to Soviet Russia, but raised a dip-
lomatic fist toward France.

Simultaneously with announce-
ment of a sharp protest to Paris
against a Franco-Chinese railway
agreement, Foreign Minister Kuni-
shi Utagaki proclaimed his Gov-
ernment's desire to establish "the
closest possible relations" with
London and the "friendlyst re-
lations" with Moscow.

But General Utagaki added in a
prepared statement to the press,
the Anti-Comintern Pact linking
Japan, Italy and Germany de-
mands more reinforcement than
ever, the Nine-Power Treaty must
be modified, and abandonment of
power by General Chiang Kai-Shek
is imperative before peace nego-
tiations could possibly be opened
between Japan and China.

Gives Warning

While some powers are withdraw-
ing their military advisors and
prohibiting export of arms and
munitions to the Chinese, the For-
eign Minister said, China accord-
ing to reports are "apparently resorting
to a policy of encouragement of
China." He warned that if re-
lations with such powers were im-
paired, it would be through no
fault of Japan.

Pledging vigorous prosecution of
the current hostilities to "a suc-
cessful conclusion," Utagaki pre-
dicted the fighting was "certainly
nearing an end."

Utagaki's friendly move toward
Soviet Russia today was followed
by a vigorous Russian protest ag-
ainst Japanese bombardment of
non-military objectives in China.

Well informed sources predicted
early opening of Soviet-proposed
negotiations between Tokyo and
Moscow on disputes which have
disturbed the dealings of the two
powers.

The Japanese protest to France
assailed a Franco-Chinese agree-
ment for construction of a railway
from French Indo-China into Kwang-
si Province of South China. Such a
project, the protest charged, would
open another route by which
lock up arms and munitions from
French territory into South China.
