### SUMMER HOUSE IN A TREE.

One of the finest and most remarkable trees in the State is the mammoth oak on the estate of William Barber in the town of Exeter. The tree is about eighteen feet in circumference at the base, and five great branches which leave the trunk about twelve feet above the ground form the support of a spacious platform which in times past was used by the owner of the farm as a summer house. The lowest of these branches, which forms the principal support for the platform, leaves the trunk of the tree almost at right angles, and the others form a symmetrical dome which provides a canopy over a dancing platform which has been built beneath the tree on the ground. The great oak formed an ideal retreat for gatherings of relatives and friends of the owner. It is located not far from Beach Pond, which a few years ago was a favorite retreat for a considerable number of summer visitors, who made the summer house among the branches their favorite rendezvous.—Providence Journal.

### PRESIDENT OF SWITZERLAND.

The president of Switzerland is so hedged about by the Constitution that, except for official purposes and to facilitate the exchange of courtesies and of amicable understandings with foreign nations, he has no more standing than the other six members of the council of which he forms a part. He is elected for one year, has no official residence, and his chief business is to sign the documents of the Bundestag or council of seven. His salary is in our money equal to about \$3600 a year, and there is no provision for private expenses, such as travelling or entertaining. He is expected to live in the capital of the country during the year he holds office. His associate members in the Bundestag get \$300 a year and they are elected for three years, their votes having the same force as that of the president. As a rule the President of Switzerland is before election a member of this council and is elected to the higher office without opposition, but in 1882 he had a rival, and though he won in the election he was unable to support what in his country is looked upon as an affront and committed suicide before his inauguration. In this connection it might be well to note, too, that Switzerland is the one country on the globe where it costs nothing to die, as in certain cantons rich and poor are buried at the expense of the state.—Harper's Weekly.
