MILITARY MEDAL.—Mr. John Cameron, Great George St. has received intimation from General Sir H. S. Rawlinson Bart. commanding the Fourth Canadian Army that his late son Pte. Frank J. Cameron had been awarded the Military Medal for gallant conduct in the battle of September 15th. In the next battle Pte. Cameron was killed while in the act of carrying a wounded comrade from the field.

PROMINENT ISLANDER'S FUNERAL.—State and city officials and men prominent in every walk of life attended the funeral of Police Commissioner Stephen O'Meara at St. Cecilia's Church in the Back Bay, Boston, this week. Judges and bankers, merchants and professional men, officials and members of the fire department, police officials and patrolmen, and men of present and past civic prominence were among the mourners. Adjutant-General Jess F. Stevens and his staff represented Governor McCall, who was unable to be present. Former President Roosevelt and United States Senator Lodge, who were on the list of honorary pall bearers, were unable to be present. All traffic on a section of Commonwealth Avenue down to Massachusetts Avenue was stopped for a short time in the morning for the passing of the impressive procession.

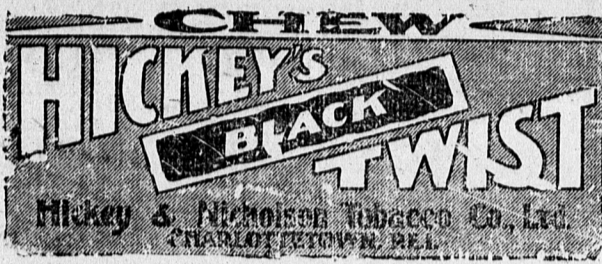
