LONDON, Ont., July 7.—(CP)—Well in advance of the first practice shooters, officials have declared the London Hunt and Country Club course in prime condition for the Canadian amateur golf championship July 26-30. The Hunt Club will be the scene of the match-play contest for the first time.
