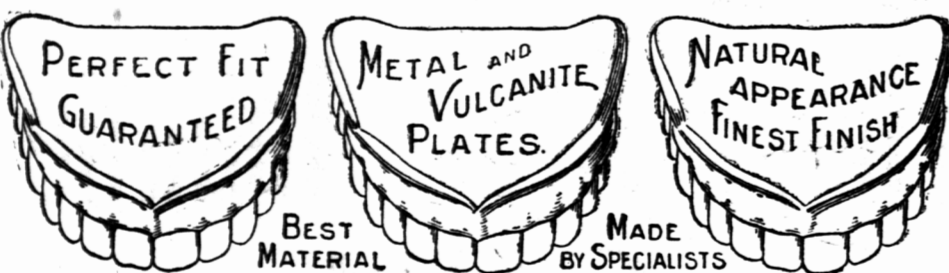

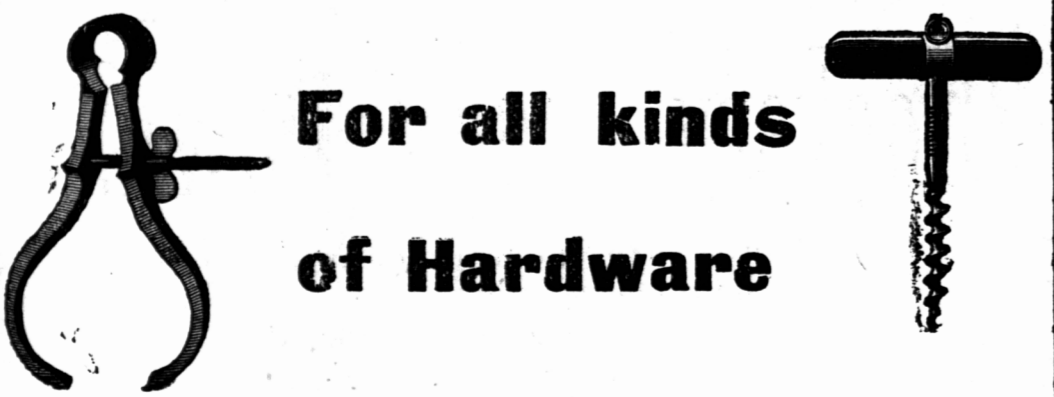

THE EDITOR'S MAIL.

The Prohibition Act 1900.

Sir: Have any steps been taken to test the constitutionality of the Prohibition Act passed last year by the Legislature of this Province?

A recent announcement intimates that the Supreme Court of Manitoba has decided that a somewhat similar statute is ultra vires of the Legislature of that Province, and that decision may tend to throw some doubt on the validity of our statute.

As the time is approaching (5th. June next) for the coming into force of the Prohibition Act 1900 and for the repeal of the present Liquor Regulation Act, would it not be well to have a competent opinion on or judicial decision on the question of the validity of this Prohibition Act so that there may be no doubt or delay as to its enforcement?

By a Dominion statute important questions of law or fact touching provincial legislation . . . or touching the constitutionality of any legislation of the Parliament of Canada, or touching any other matter with reference to which he sees fit to exercise this power, may be referred, by the Governor (i. e. the Governor General) in Council to the Supreme Court (of Canada) for hearing or consideration and the Court shall certify its opinion on the questions referred with the reasons therefor. Provision is also made by this statute that in case the question to be referred relates to the constitutional validity of any act passed by the Legislature of any Province, or affects any class of persons, such Province or persons may be represented by counsel who may argue the case before the Court.

Should not our local Government see to it that questions of the validity of this statute be by this or some other means placed beyond dispute if possible before the time comes for actively enforcing the Act?

ALUMINUM DECK SHAMROCK II.

GLASGOW, Feb. 25.—The Associated Press learns that aluminum will be used for the deck of the Shamrock II., with a view of saving top weight. The first of the plates have just been delivered at Dunbarton. On top of the aluminum plates the whole deck will be covered with a thin sheeting of wood, this serving the double purpose of protecting the metal from the corroding effect of salt water and giving the crew a better foothold. Designer Watson decided that this composite deck would be both much lighter and stronger than one of wood, and he considers valuable every pound of top weight saved.

PARIS, February 25.—In a remarkable paper presented before the Academy of Medicine to-day, Dr. Lucas Championare demonstrated that one of the common causes of appendicitis is the grip of influenza.

The savant called attention to the fact, that an epidemic of appendicitis has ever followed a grip epidemic, or that the two often co-existed. He then demonstrated that appendicitis is but a localization of the grip affecting the intestines, and often the appendix itself.

The paper cited innumerable instances where this has been directly proved by careful observation, the coincidence parallel symptoms in every case observed admitting of no doubt.

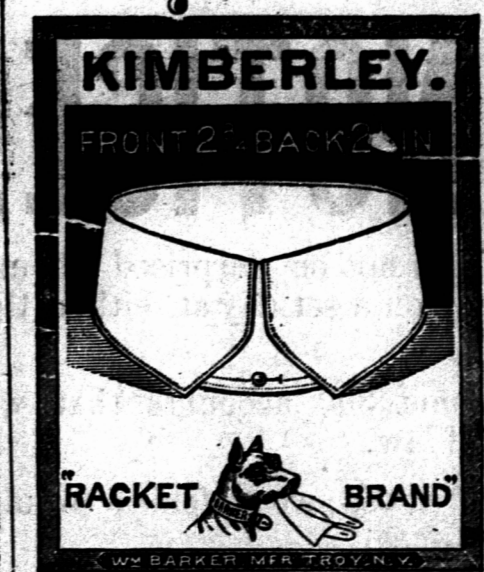
