JESTER

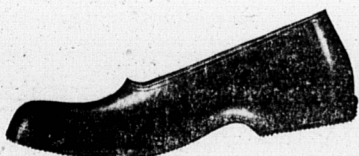
Carried in stock in Men's Boys' and Youths—Short, red sole, called Robin Hood.

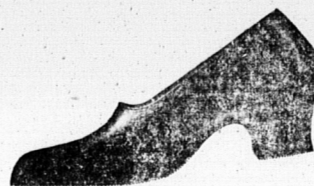


KINGSPORT

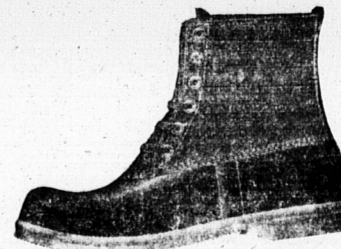
DONEGAL
