

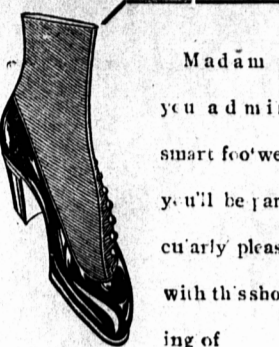

TO STAND TRIAL ON MURDER CHARGE. SYDNEY, September 19.—Frank Haynes was committed to the supreme court this morning by Stipendiary W. R. Hearn to stand trial charged with the murder of Benjamin S. Atkinson on Friday, the 15th day of August.
