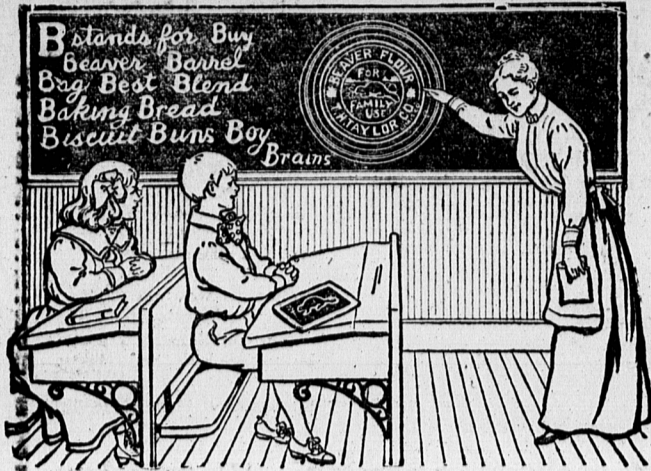

Real Center of Population. Two men made the same blunder when wrestling with a string of figures, and the center of population was located eight miles out of plumb. The mistake has been corrected by the census bureau. The new center of population is in Bloomington, Monroe county, Ind., eight miles west of its previous location at Unionville, in the same county. The error occurred in multiplying 31,098 population by its distance from the assumed meridian of 1,851 miles. This work is done in duplicate, and two clerks say they made the same error.

Sign of the Medic. "The ancient house of Medic, whose representatives were the business princes of London and whose Lombardian representative gave its name to Lombard street, in the financial district of that city, has been outlived by its coat of arms," says a letter from Bremen in a Vienna newspaper. "The three gilded globes have for many years been used as a sign by pawnbrokers in England and America. The sign has now made its appearance in Germany, an importation from Italy by way of England and America."

Titles For Cities. American cities used to be called shortly and simply by their proper names. Then journalism and the greatly demanded synonyms, and they became known by various historical or romantic characteristics—as the Garden City, the City of Churches, Quaker City, Gotham, the Hub, and so on. Now we are come into a third period, when each city has its commercial or "boosting" title.—Chicago Post.

Panama Canal Pageant. What vessel shall lead the grand pageant of the navies of the world through the Panama canal when it is formally opened? The event is some distance in the future, but the question is already being discussed. Some urge the Oregon, in recognition of its famous trip round the continent at the outbreak of the war with Spain. Others suggest the old sailing man-of-war Portsmouth, which was the defender of the Pacific coast during the Mexican war and which ran up the American flag at Yerba Buena, now San Francisco. The Portsmouth is now at Norfolk as a quarantine ship.—Youth's Companion.

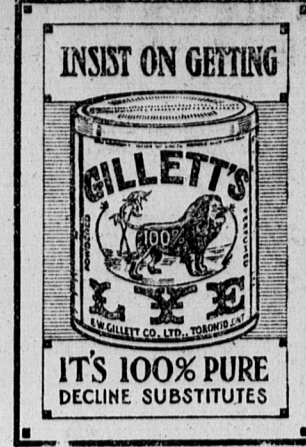

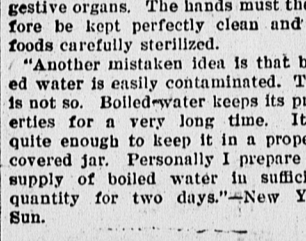
TOSCANE CAKE. Beat up three ounces of butter with three ounces of sugar to a cream; then add three well beaten eggs and half a teaspoonful of vanilla extract. Sift in three ounces of rice flour, add half a pound of cocoanut; mix well and divide into small buttered cake tins. Bake in a moderate oven for fifteen or twenty minutes.

NOT AFRAID OF CHOLERA. Professor Metchnikoff Says It is Easy to Avoid the Disease.

The possibility of an outbreak of cholera in France led Professor Metchnikoff of the Pasteur Institute in Paris to express his opinion on the subject. Among other things he says: "Cholera is not dangerous. It is easy to protect oneself from it. I have lived in contaminated areas and never felt the least fear. The measures taken by the government are excellent, but I must confess I have only a moderate confidence in them. The only measures to be taken are individual measures."

"The strictest hygiene must be observed. One must wash often, but above all all drinking water must be boiled and all fruit scalded. People who eat their melons without fear. They run no risk. The only essential precaution is to plunge the melons in boiling water for a minute, for the rind may have fragments of earth on it containing the germs which propagate cholera. These germs will die at once. The same is true of all fruits. Cholera and typhoid fever can contaminate any one only by means of the digestive organs. The hands must therefore be kept perfectly clean and all foods carefully sterilized."

"Another mistaken idea is that boiled water is easily contaminated. That is not so. Boiled water keeps its properties for a very long time. It is quite enough to keep it in a properly covered jar. Personally I prepare my supply of boiled water in sufficient quantity for two days."—New York Sun.

BAKED BEET ROOTS.

Wash the beet root thoroughly, being very careful not to break the skin or any of the fibre. Place in a rather slow oven and bake for four or five hours. When done, peel and serve with melted butter, salt and pepper, or cold with a vinegar sauce. Beet roots are seldom cooked in this way owing to the length of time it takes, but they are delicious and very wholesome.

WHITE FUDGE.

Boil two cupfuls of sugar with one of milk until the syrup forms a soft ball when dropped into cold water. Add one tablespoonful of butter, one cupful nut-meats, dates, figs and raisins run through the chopper. Beat until the candy is nearly stiff, then turn on to a buttered tin and mark into squares.
