NEW TELESCOPE MAY SHOW LIFE ON MARS

Baltimore Man Working on an Instrument Expected to Tell Secrets of Planets.

BALTIMORE, Md., November 23.—R. W. Wood, who occupies the chair of experimental physics at Johns Hopkins University, has worked out a mercury telescope by which it is hoped that life, if it exists, may be seen on the planet Mars.

The fundamental principle of the new telescope is that a liquid surface, such as mercury, when set in rotation, becomes concave, assuming the form of a perfect paraboloid, which is the form of surface best adapted to telescope mirrors.

able, the construction of a much larger one will be undertaken. One of the great advantages of the mercury mirror that the local strength can be made as long or as short as one pleases by altering the speed of rotation.

Professor Wood refused to make any definite statement as to the future possibilities of the instrument. It is possible, he said, that a mirror fifteen or twenty feet in diameter mounted in the top of a lighthouse of a deep pit might enable people to observe details on Mars and the other planets which cannot be seen with smaller instruments.

ORDERS STRICT QUARANTINE

Border Customs Officials Get Instructions. No Foot and Mouth Disease In Canada.

OTTAWA, Nov. 23.—Telegraphic orders were sent out by the department of customs last week to all its officers along the frontier to establish a rigid quarantine against cattle and hides from New York state. This action was taken in consequence of the discovery of foot and mouth disease among cattle in Buffalo stock yards.

Some days ago quarantine was ordered against cattle and hides from Pennsylvania, when the disease first manifested itself, and whence doubtless, it spread to New York state.

The most stringent precautions will be taken to prevent the introduction of the infection into Canada, and inspectors will be sent out at once by the department of agriculture to see that the quarantine regulations are rigidly enforced.

It is many years since the disease last appeared in the Dominion, and it was at that time stamped out only by close quarantine and the slaughter of infected herds.
