### MINING

TORONTO, Oct. 15—(CP)—Copper and other base metal listings boomed along with gusto in today's Toronto mining market, lifting the exchange index for the miscellaneous group to a new high for the last five years.

Noranda and Sudbury Basin both sold at new highs, the former up to 67 1-2 and Sudbury at 5.70. These prices were shaded a little in the last half hour.

A 10-cent price for copper, the highest in five years provided the stimulant. Sherritt-Gordon traded 30,000 shares and closed 7 cents up at 1.77.

Wright Hargreaves was marketed freely as low as 7.60, down 10 cents and Pioneer in smaller volume was off 20. Dome dropped 1-2, Lake Shore 1-8 Central Patricia 15 and Anglo-Huronian 25.
