A recent Winnipeg paper contains the following paragraph regarding the election of a new source of water supply for that city. The E. S. Lea, referred to as one of the board of consulting engineers is a son of W. G. Lea, Craupud: "A special meeting of the water commission was held this morning for the purpose of meeting the board of engineers called to the city to consider a suitable source of supply for Winnipeg. The board is composed of Messrs. Whipple and Furtess, New York; R. Lea, Montreal, and J. Schwitzer, O. P. R. Winnipeg. The meeting was called for the purpose of affording the engineers all the available information on the different sources of supply which might be considered, as suitable for a permanent water supply for Winnipeg."

A later issue states "R. S. Lea, one of the members of the board of engineers stated that the board had intended going to Kinkora tonight, thence to Shoal Lake but had been unable to secure a boat. They are now waiting for a telegram announcing that a steamer has been secured, when they will start. Mr. Lea also stated that the engineers would probably visit Winnipeg river and look into the proposition there after dealing with Shoal Lake. The engineers have as yet only made a cursory examination of the bed river and will return to it after investigating the other proposed sources."
