

# ARREARS OF TAXES.

## NOTICE TO DEFAULTERS

Notice is hereby given that the Act passed by the Legislature in 1907, to provide a more speedy and simple method for the collection of Arrears of Taxes, will be put into force at once for the collection of Arrears of 1906 and all previous years. The new Act does not require proceedings to be taken against the land, the advertising of the same nor the mailing of Final Notices to Defaulters; and it gives the Government the additional power, after the Tax is one month over due, of suing in any Court, and of levying on all goods and chattels found on the premises or in possession of the party sued. Where there are no goods and chattels, or not sufficient to levy on, proceedings will be taken against the land under the old Act as heretofore.

The new Act, as well as the old, declares all taxes to be "Crown debts," having priority over all other Claims, Judgements, Mortgages, Bills of Sale etc. All Taxes will be sued for in the name of the King.

Persons in Arrears for Land, Road or Income Tax are requested to make immediate payment to save expenses.

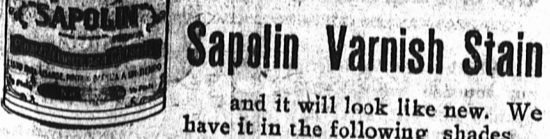

# EDGAR W. MEIKLE NOW ON TRIAL

## Massachusetts State Police Accuse Him of Firing Shot Which Killed His Father, Charles S. G. Meikle, Formerly of Charlottetown

SALEM, May 3.—Edgar Weston Meikle, the sixteen-year-old school boy of Lynn, who has been in jail here ever since last October, charged by the State Police with having murdered his father, Charles S. G. Meikle, who lived with the boy in a little house at No. 22 Congress street, until November 7, 1905, when he died of a revolver shot, is to be placed on trial May 21 in the Superior Criminal Court here.

The Lynn police and the medical examiner after holding an autopsy into the death of the elder Meikle decided that he had committed suicide in the presence of his son and that the boy was entirely guiltless. All of Edgar's neighbors and friends held stoutly the same opinion, but the State police were not satisfied and last October he was arrested after it had been thought that the case was dropped. Since then the lad had remained in jail. Charles S. G. Meikle met his death in his Congress street home, Lynn, on November 7, 1905. A revolver shot was heard in the house, and soon Edgar came running from it, saying that his father had shot himself. The boy said that his father had come home from the General Electric Works, where he was employed, in a despondent mood and that while they were talking together in the kitchen his father had drawn the revolver and shot himself. Edgar says that he ran to his father's side, but it was too late. He placed the revolver on a refrigerator nearby and at once gave the alarm.

The state police claimed that the bullet having entered Meikle's left cheek and being right handed could not have done the deed. They claimed that Edgar and his father had been having a quarrel and that the boy shot the fatal bullet. Mr. and Mrs. Joseph S. Trimble, of No. 59 Lexington street, Lynn, at once assumed Edgar's guardianship, and he lived with them until arrested. (It will be remembered that the Meikle family formerly belonged to this city.)

## HORSE NOTES

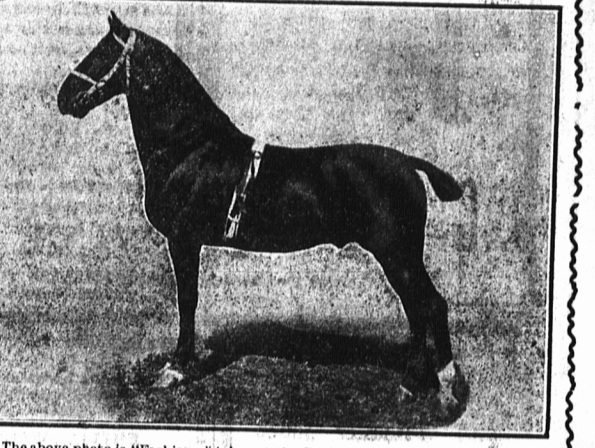
