HALIFAX, Sept. 30.—Frank Stephen yesterday received a letter from Charles Bigges, of Toronto, stating that Newman, of the Lakeview Association, wished to race either Frank or Kraedzlein, on a cinder track at Toronto, for a \$200 cup. Frank sent word that he has settled down to business for the rest of the year and cannot go to Toronto again just now.

It is likely, however, that if Newman will come to Halifax, he will get a race with Frank on the Wanderers' track.

Biggar, it will be remembered remarked after the Canadian championship that Stephen is the best sprinter Canada has ever produced.

Of Newman the Ottawa Journal said at the time: "Newman, of the Lake View Athletic Association, who was third in this event, created a lot of talk on account of the conduct of a party of friends as well as himself. He had a bet to say about what he would do and his friends offered to bet all kinds of money that he would win the 100 and 220 yard races. He was taken up quite liberally, particularly by the Americans, and his group quite a bit as a favorite. He did better than third in the hundred and did not qualify for the final of the 220 yards."
