## GRAIN

CHICAGO, April 16—(AP)—Influenced by European war news all wheat contracts and July and September corn futures rushed into new seasonal high ground today with gains ranging up to 2 cents a bushel.

Wheat closed 1-8-1-8 higher. May 1-10-1-4, July 1-09-1-09, 1-8; Corn 1-5-8-2 cents up, May 62 1-88-1-4, July 63 3-8; Oats 3-8-1-2 higher.

WINNIPEG, April 16—(CP)—Good general buying marked wheat trading on Winnipeg grain exchange today and wheat futures prices made higher ground. Closing quotations were 3-8 above yesterday's closing levels with May at 90 3-8, July 91 3-4 and Oct 93 3-8 cents.

The price range at Winnipeg was more than a cent above yesterday's closing level at times and the October future made a new seasonal high.

Buenos Aires was 7-8-1-8 cent up at mid-day in the Argentine.

## Livestock

MONTREAL, April 16—(CP)—There were 80 cattle, four sheep, 1,135 hogs and 2,274 calves for sale on Montreal livestock markets today.

Cattle and hogs were firm and calves 25 cents higher. The cattle were practically all plain to medium cows, and were sold at \$3 to \$5.25.

Calves were higher. Good veals made \$7.50 to \$8 with medium light kinds down to \$5. The bulk of the calves were of common to just fair quality and were sold in mixed lots between \$6 to \$6.50, averaging around \$6.25.

Hogs were firm at \$9.40 for bacon-fed and watered and \$9.50 for trucks. Selects drew \$1 per hog premium with the regular cuts on off grades. Sows were \$5 to \$6. Hogs sold on rail grade made \$12.40 hot weight.

STOCKHOLM, April 15—(AP)—Via Radio—The Norwegian government tonight announced it was broadcasting over radio stations still controlled by the following warning to Norwegian ships—

"Telegrams which you receive from Norway signed by the owners are dispatched by German authorities."

Orders received from the Norwegian legation (in Washington, D. C.) or broadcast over the British broadcasting station, are authentic. "Masters on the high seas may contact the nearest allied naval authorities and ought to avoid sailing at neutral ports."

## FINANCE

### NEW YORK, April 16—(AP)—

An already tired-looking stock market fell off its perch today, leaders tumbling 1-3 points at the worst.

Brokers attributed the reaction partly to a batch of rumors, the principal one being that the Germans had, or were about to invade Rumania.

Among Canadian issues Bell Telephone dropped three points, Dome one point, and International Nickel one point. Distillers, Walker and Ford were fractionally lower.

The Associated Press average of 60 stocks was off 4 of a point at 50.1. Transfers totalled 1,505,860 shares against 1,261,040 the day before.

Among the losers were Douglas Aircraft, Glenn Martin, Lockheed, Boeing, American Airlines, U. S. Steel, Sears Roebuck, Anacosta, Kennecott, DuPont, Allied Chemical, Eastman Kodak, Texas Corp., Socony-Vacuum, International Paper preferred, Standard Oils of Indiana and California, American
