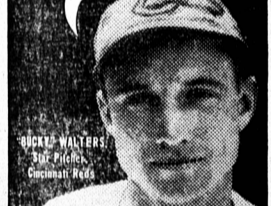
Blackhawk Takes Straight Heat Victory
