### MANY ITALIAN RIOTERS CONVICTED

The Jury Had 2453 Questions to Decide in Giving Verdict.

ROME, Oct 1.—Another big Sarlinian trial, which has occupied the Capital Assize Court since June 17, was concluded last week, with the condemnation of fifty-four out of eighty-seven prisoners concerned in the tramway riots of May, 1906, in which all the locomotives, rolling stock stations and other property of the local company were destroyed, the damage exceeding \$400,000.

When the unfortunate jurymen retired the judges handed them 2453 questions for solution. The twelve martyrs accomplished this feat while locked up for three nights.
