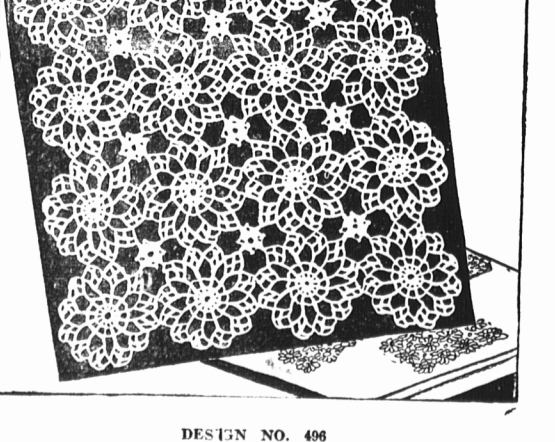

A Job Only You Can Do Price Control Questions And Answers

Q. Can sugar be obtained for canteens serving the armed forces? A. Yes. Restrictions as to the purchase of sugar do not apply to purchases by the Red Cross Society or for any canteen or mess situated within the limits of naval, military or air force camps, barracks, dockyards or similar establishments.

Q. Are any exemptions made in the cases where there is definite individual hardship caused by compliance with the regulations? A. Yes. The Sugar Administrator may at his discretion grant exemption or make a special order, to deal with cases of individual hardship. Cases should be presented by letter to the nearest Ration Office of the Wartime Price and Trade Board.

Q. What is the penalty for deliberate infringement of the law governing sugar rationing? A. Any person who fails to observe the provision of this Order, or who deliberately makes a false statement on an application for or purchase voucher is liable on conviction to a penalty not exceeding \$5,000 dollars or a term of imprisonment not exceeding two years or both.

Q. How soon is a baby entitled to a ration card? A. Directly after birth. An application form should be obtained from the post office filled in and posted to the nearest Ration Office.

Q. What should be done with a ration card on the death of its owner? A. It should be immediately returned to the nearest Ration Office by the next to kin.

Q. Must fruit be purchased at the same time and from the same store in order to obtain sugar for preserving? A. No. This regulation only applied to the purchase of fruit for marmalade last February. This method of control has been abandoned.

Q. What do consumers do with sugar already in their households, or left over after they have finished preserving? A. Only two weeks' ration of sugar per head must be in the household at any one time. Excess must not be used to buy more sugar until all existing stocks are within the two weeks' limit.

Q. What must consumers do with their ration cards if they make use of a regular delivery service instead of carrying their sugar personally from the store? A. The delivery man is empowered to collect the necessary coupons which must be detached from the cards at the door and given to him.

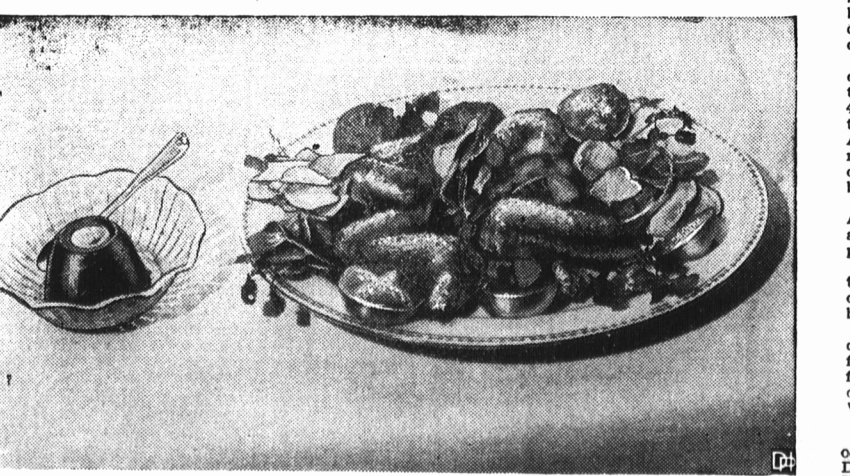

Chicken Is Good Substitute For Pork, Beef



Canadians have been asked to refrain from buying pork in order that the meat that Britain so urgently needs may be sent to her. There are, however, plentiful supplies of poultry available which is good news, as there is probably no other meat with so high a popularity rating. Fried chicken that melts in the mouth can be prepared by the following method, recommended by the Consumer's Section of the Department of Agriculture, Ottawa. Have the butcher skin the birds. Simmer gently until tender, about 20 minutes, with out the addition of salt which tends to dry out the flesh. Allow to cool. Cut in individual portions. Dip each portion in seasoned flour, egg and fine breadcrumbs and fry in deep fat 375 degrees for 5 minutes. A moist, tender product of better appearance and flavor is the result, and larger birds can be successfully prepared by this method than when the chicken is not precooked.
