Ontario Fruit Growers.

Whitby, Ont., Dec. 7.—Prof. Robertson endorsed what had been said about the dishonest packing of apples. The Ontario fruit growers practically concluded their annual convention here yesterday. Abundant testimony to the value of spraying was given by many experts, and Prof. Robertson emphasized what had been said about the dishonest packing of Canadian apples. Prof. Saunders exhibited some new hybrid apples that are expected to stand the rigorous climate of the North-West. A resolution was unanimously carried approving of the action of the Department of Agriculture in taking measures to stamp out the San Jose scale and regretting that there should be any relaxation of the law.

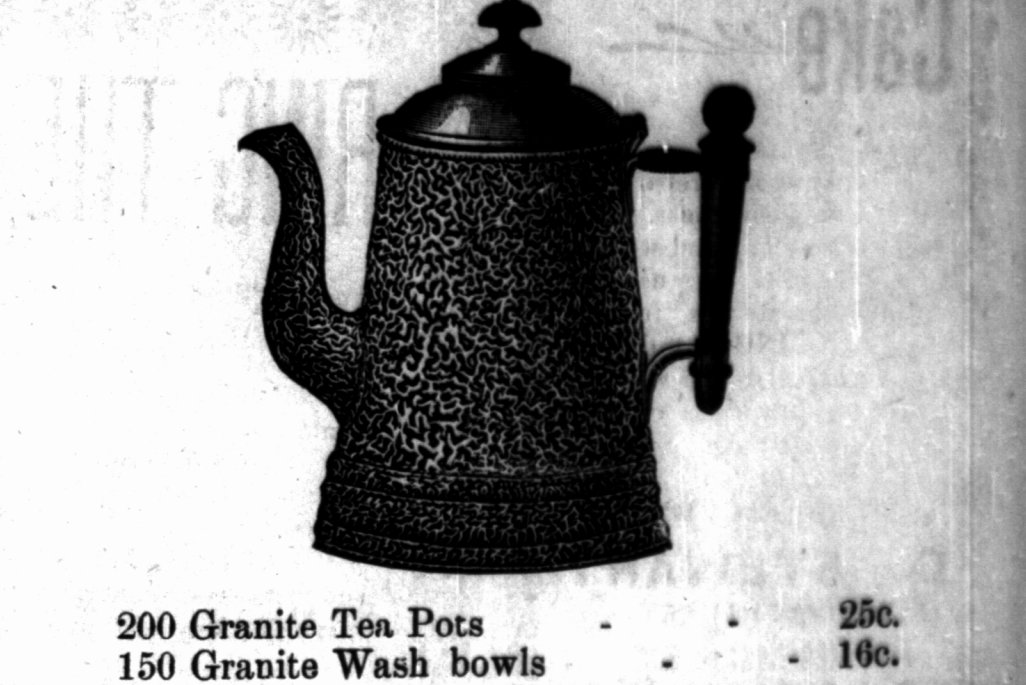
