## ALL CANADIAN ROUTE TO DAWSON

OTTAWA, Sept. 24.—The mounted police after two years' work, have cut an eight-foot trail from Peace River through the Rocky Mountains, giving a route from Edmonton to Dawson, entirely over Canadian territory. Colonel White, head of the mounted police, this morning received a telegram from Commissioner Perry of the police, announcing his arrival on the Pacific coast, after a seven hundred mile ride on the train from Edmonton. The trail has been built to Hazelton, where it joins the trail along the line of the Dawson telegraph, and thus continues to the Yukon capital. The trail besides affording access to an hitherto inaccessible portion of the country, will be useful for justice purposes in transporting prisoners who would be able to take advantage of territorial enmity if taken over the usual route of travellers which crosses American territory.

## SEAMAN DROWNED ON VOYAGE OUT

Dominion Line Encounters Severe Gale on Atlantic—Man Washed Overboard.

MONTREAL, Sept. 24.—The steamship Dominion, of the Dominion Line, which arrived in port Monday, encountered one of the most severe gales of recent years on the North Atlantic. While in mid-ocean William Roberts, an able-bodied seaman, was swept overboard by a gigantic wave, and T. J. Rowland, the ship's quartermaster, had two ribs broken and is now in the hospital. Roberts, who was clad in oilskins when he was swept overboard, managed to throw them off in the water, but although the ship was stopped and lifeboats thrown overboard, he sank on the point of grasping a buoy. The passengers subscribed £30 for Roberts' widowed mother, whose sole support he was.

While in that city Mr. Lee took great interest in the U. N. B. team.
