Maritime Trust Progress

The report of the Maritime Trust Company for 1945 is of a highly satisfactory character, as is evidenced from the statements submitted at the annual meeting and published in this issue. The Chairman of the Board of Directors, President Howard P. Robinson, pointed out that the improvement in the position of the Company's shareholders from the standpoint of money available for dividends had been brought about during the past year by improved earnings. This improvement, came through a greater demand for their services on the part of clients in the territory served. The increased volume of business was reflected in the value of the estates, trusts and agency accounts under administration at the closing of our books on December 31, 1945, which stood at \$4,812,886.17, an increase during the year of \$956,640.48. Their bond trusteeships during the same period had increased from \$4,873,200, to \$6,143,200. Their net earnings with the same federal tax encumbrances as during the war years, had increased from \$5,684.00 to \$9,443.00. Their Directors had continued the principle of keeping the operation of the Company strictly as a trust company business. They had continued investments in Dominion, Provincial and other high grade securities. The annual Dominion inspection by the Department of Insurance at Ottawa had been made and also a continuous audit by the Company's own auditors. He was pleased to announce that the Directors felt justified in authorizing a dividend of 4%, payable March 1, 1946, to shareholders of record of January 1, 1946.
