EIGHTH ANNUAL SHOW OF POULTRY ASSOCIATION

The eighth annual show of the Prince Edward Island Poultry Association was opened yesterday morning in the Gardener Building, Queen Street, Charlottetown, when a splendid variety of birds was put on exhibition. The show, which extends over to-day and to-morrow, is well up to the standard and there is a fine representation in every class.

The classes include plymouth rocks, wyandottes, orpingtons, leghorns, minorcas, Rhode Island reds, langshans, Brahams, game birds of different varieties, andalusians, cochins, dorkings, bantams, ducks and geese.

In the wyandotte class, which is well represented, there are about 45 birds, the exhibitors being Mr George Lightizer, the Spring Park Poultry Yard, Mr Henry Laphorne and Mr George Williams. White and brown leghorns are represented by 40 birds, owned by Messrs R. Haynes and Wm. Pickard. Mr W. J. Cudmore is the only exhibitor of black minorcas, of which he has some 30. Of Rhode Island reds there are 35, exhibited by Messrs J. O. Hyndman, Arthur Nelson and Lorne Pickard. Mr George Cudmore is showing about 20 buff orpingtons. Mr Alfred Houston, of the Spring Park Poultry Yard, has a fine variety of bantams, about 30, and a pretty pair of frizzlers. Indian game birds are shown by Mr George Williams, pencilled Hamburgs by the Spring Park Poultry Yard. Mr Henry Laphorne has 10 of the finest birds in the show, his partridge wyandottes being exceedingly pretty. He has taken 5 first prizes.

The judging was done by Mr T. C. Layton, of Pictou, and Mr L. A. Hazard, Charlottetown, who did their duty with the utmost care and impartiality and to the entire satisfaction of all. The building was kindly placed at the disposal of the Association by Mr Isaac Carter.
