LONDON HAS AN ELECTRIC "L" NOW

LONDON, Dec. 19—London's first "elevated electric"—or the new railway which is expected to be of very great benefit to Londoners has been officially designated by the Brighton Railway Company—was inaugurated this week with, it would seem, every prospect of success. The work of equipping this line has been very protracted and costly, and the original estimate as to both time and money was largely exceeded. It is expected that the line will stay the steady drain of traffic by

the competing tram cars. From the point of view of the travelling public the service is likely to prove popular, seeing that it confers the three-fold advantages of quicker transit, greater comfort and cheaper fares—a conjunction of benefits which may reasonably be expected to attract back to the railways some portion of the traffic of which it has been deprived by the electric tram cars. If the hopes of the company are realized the directors will extend the system.
