THE PROPOSED REFORM TARIFF IN BRITAIN.

The tariff reformers in England have at length definitely shown their hand by outlining the kind of tariff they will propose if returned to power at the coming election. They say it will be simple in form, not protective, but covering all classes of raw material except a few and manufactured goods, with the object of raising the necessary revenue, assisting the home producer against foreign competition, mitigating unemployment and securing better terms from foreign countries.

There will be duties of five per cent on partly manufactured goods, ten per cent on articles nearly completed and fifteen per cent on finished manufactures. There may be slightly lower duties in favor of the British possessions, and slightly higher duties on the goods and products of foreign countries that discriminate against British goods. Cotton and wool will still be free of duty. Wheat will pay two shillings per quarter (six cents per bushel) and flour will be taxed higher to encourage British milling.

It is estimated that such a tariff will produce from eighty to one hundred millions of dollars in addition to the import duties already in force, although some of the latter may be reduced. We are accustomed to speak of the United Kingdom as a free trade country, but such is not the case. Spirits and beer imported pay \$175,000,000 in duties, while tea and coffee pay \$30,000,000, sugar \$15,000,000, and cocoa, chicory and dried fruits together pay \$3,910,000 more. Here are nearly fifty millions of dollars levied upon food and drink stuffs apart from spirits and beer.

It may be doubted whether the publication of the proposed new duties will help the Unionist cause in the elections more than it will hurt it. But there is certainly a strong cause for imposing duties on German, French and United States manufactures which now enter the British market free, while British manufactures are met with heavy duties wherever they are sent about the world, even in the British lands beyond the seas. And the proposed tariff thus formulated will serve to distract attention from the high-handed action of the Lords in rejecting the budget.

Colonel ex-President Roosevelt has been heard from by letters reporting that he and Kermit are in the best of health and spirits. Mrs. Roosevelt intends to meet them at Khartoum about the middle of March and the party will then proceed to Europe. Col. Roosevelt will deliver addresses in Berlin, Paris and London, sailing from the latter city for New York early in June.

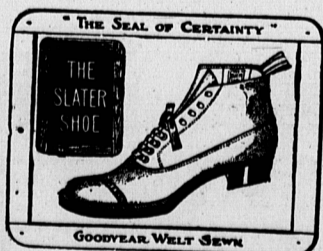

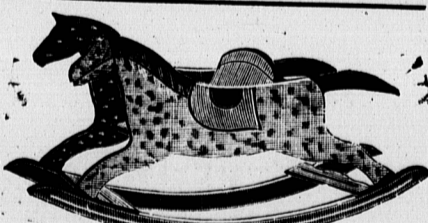
