MESSRS. Wright Bros. bought last week over 7,000 bushels of oats from the farmers of Crapaud and vicinity.

THE schooner Swift Current is now loading at Crapaud a general cargo of produce for the Sydney market by Wright Bros.

MACK BIGNBY, a former employee of The Guardian, whose accidental shooting at Amherst was referred to on Saturday, died yesterday morning.

Rev. J. E. Fraser has arrived at Upper LaHave from P. E. Island to take charge of the Anglican congregation there. He is a recent graduate of Kings.

EARLY CRAPAUD SHIPMENTS.—The schooner Precursor sailed from Crapaud yesterday for Glace Bay, C. B., with 900 bushels oats, 500 bushels potatoes, 200 bushels turnips, 14 tons hay and a quantity of beets and cabbage. Also schr. Rialto and North Star sail today for Pictou with 4,500 bushels oats. Above three cargoes were loaded by Wright Bros.

THE Presbyterian church at Marshfield having been enlarged and extensively reviewed will be reopened on Sabbath next Sept. 21. Dedication Services will be conducted as follows:—At 11 o'clock by Rev. F. F. Fullerton, at 3 o'clock by Rev. C. P. Wilson, at 7 o'clock by Rev. J. W. McConnell. Offerings will be taken at all the services in favor of the Improvement Expense Fund.

THE sermon on the Sabbath question preached in the Central Christian church on Sunday evening last will be subjected to a candid and full review to-night at eight o'clock. Dr. Heard, who is a native of Charlottetown and a graduate of McGill, left the Island in 1880 and has been for the past sixteen years located in Sydney where he enjoys a lucrative practice. He holds an honorary M. D. from Melbourne University, only five of which are extant. He returned by way of Cape Town, and England on the same ship with Botha, Dewitt and De la Rey, the Boer generals and was their medical attendant on the trip. He secured the autographs of each of them, that of Dewitt being very rare, and on that account valuable. Dr. Heard arrived on Saturday night and had already met many old friends who are glad to greet him again after an absence of 22 years. His stay on the Island will regrettably be limited to the next few days.

KILL HORSES WHICH HAVE GLANDERS.

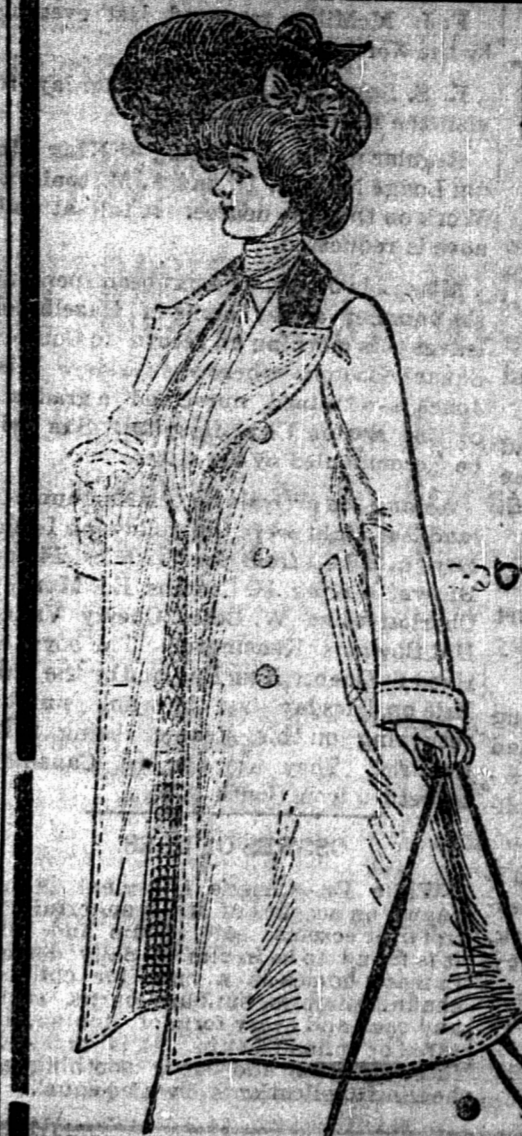

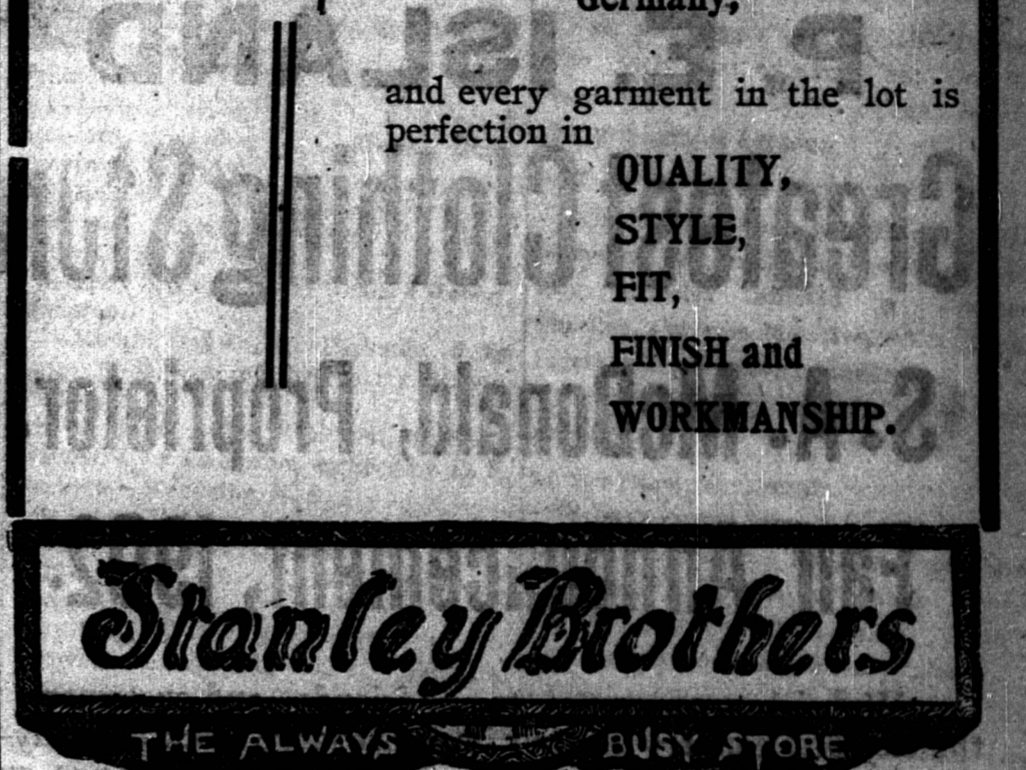
